Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 45th meeting, on 4 December 1980, the Fifth Committee considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/56) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution A/35/L.11/Rev.1. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee for Administrative and Budgetary Questions were expressed orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the summary record of the meeting (A/C.5/35/SR.45).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/35/L.11/Rev.1, the related conference-servicing costs, not to exceed \$139,970, would be reviewed in the context of a consolidated statement on total conference-servicing requirements, to be submitted to the General Assembly towards the end of its current session.
4. The representative of the United States of America explained his position after the decision.
