REVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE STRENGTHENING OF INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

Letter dated 30 May 1984 from the Permanent Representative of Somalie to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to transmit, on the instruction of my Government, the text of a telegram concerning yet another act of wanton aggression by Ethiopia against densely populated civilian centres of my country:

- On Thursday, 24 May 1984, Ethiopian war-planes attacked the district of Aabud Waaq in Galgudud Region, causing considerable loss of life and damage to property.
- On Friday, 25 May 1984, Ethiopian war-planes attacked the city of Baidoa, causing the death of four young boys.
- On Monday, 28 May 1984, Ethiopian war-planes attacked the city of Galkaio, causing considerable loss of life and damage to property.
- I shall, of course, keep you informed of any further developments.

I should be grateful if you would be so kind as to circulate this letter as an official document of the General Assembly under item 68 of the preliminary list.
