Letter dated 14 December 1984 from the Permanent Representative
of Afghanistan to the United Nations addressed to the
Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that a spokesman of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan stated, on 12 December 1984, that as a result of shellings of long-range and heavy weapons by the aggressive Pakistani military forces, stationed in the vicinity of Afghanistan territory, on Pishangro village of Kunar province at 12:00 noon on 8 December 1984, a girl was injured and a number of houses were destroyed.

Similarly, the spokesman added, as a result of shellings by heavy weaponry from Pakistani territory on the military garrison of Kunar province at 11:00 on 10 December 1984, a member of the military personnel of the garrison was seriously injured.

In connection with these aggressions, the Chargé d'Affaires of the Pakistan Embassy in Kabul was summoned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on 12 December 1984 and the following was conveyed to him by the In-Charge of the First Political Department:

"The Democratic Republic of Afghanistan considers these irresponsible, provocative and armed aggressions of the Pakistani authorities, which intensify tensions on the frontiers of the two countries, as a serious threat to peace in the region and strongly protests to the Government of Pakistan in this regard.

"The Democratic Republic of Afghanistan once again points out that the Pakistani concerned authorities must discontinue immediately their armed aggression against the territory of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan; otherwise, the heavy responsibility for the unpleasant consequences of such hostile actions shall be totally borne by the concerned authorities of Pakistan."

I have further the honour to request Your Excellency to arrange for the circulation of this letter as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 68, 69, 123, 124, 129 and 143, and of the Security Council.
