At its 42nd meeting, on 6 December 1988, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General ($\lambda/C.5/43/58$) on the programme budget implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report ($\lambda/43/860$).
