ANNEX

Decision of the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic

Proceeding from the larger interests of the strengthening of trust and co-operation in inter-state relations and also with a view to implementing the party's policy on enhancing the growth of the national economy and increasing the financial and manpower resources devoted to raising the people's well being, the Central Committee of the Mongolian People's Revolutionary Party and the Council of Ministers of the Mongolian People's Republic decided to reduce the country's armed forces by 13,000 men in the course of 1989-1990.

It was also decided to transfer 1,000 vehicles and trucks and 90 caterpillar carriers to the needs of national economy.
