of the Permanent Mission of Yugoslavia to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

In connection with the letter dated 14 September 1994 from the Permanent Representative of Croatia to the United Nations addressed to you (A/49/383-S/1994/1052), upon the instructions of my Government, I have the honour to state the following.

The Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia strongly rejects the absurd allegations contained in the above-mentioned letter. Such blatant fabrications are aimed solely at discrediting the constructive role and contribution of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the peaceful solution of the crisis in the former Yugoslavia, which are widely acknowledged by the international community.

In doing so, Croatia's authorities continue with the policy of pursuing a campaign of slander and falsehoods against the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia that may satisfy certain internal political interests but cannot in any contribute to an overall peaceful settlement.

The Federal Republic of Yugoslavia expects the Republic of Croatia to honour its expressed readiness to normalize its relations with the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, which, for its part, is investing great efforts towards that end.
