



RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

*Amendments adopted by the General Assembly
during its twenty-third session*

1. By resolution 2479 (XXIII) of 21 December 1968, the General Assembly decided to include Russian among the working languages of the Assembly and to amend accordingly rule 51 of its rules of procedure. The rule as amended reads as follows:

Rule 51

Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish shall be the official languages of the General Assembly, its committees and sub-committees. English, French, Russian and Spanish shall be the working languages.

2. By resolution 2390 (XXIII) of 25 November 1968, the General Assembly decided to increase the membership of the Committee on Contributions from ten to twelve and to amend, with effect from 1 January 1969, rule 159 of its rules of procedure to read as follows:

Rule 159

The General Assembly shall appoint an expert Committee on Contributions, consisting of twelve members.
