## Declaration of the States members of the Collective Security Treaty Organization regarding the ratification of the Agreement on Adaptation of the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe

The States members of the Collective Security Treaty Organization consider the adapted Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe to be fundamental to ensuring security and stability in Europe. They will consequently do their utmost to accelerate the implementation of the political commitment entered into in Istanbul in 1999 and will take practical action to encourage completion of the national procedures for the ratification of the Agreement on Adaptation of the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe.

The States members of the Collective Security Treaty Organization hope that all the States Parties to the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe will take similar action, enabling the Treaty to remain an important instrument of security, stability and confidence in Europe and enabling new States Parties to join it, thus substantially strengthening the architecture of European security.
