

Addendum

- 1. The Secretary-General has received notification of the resignation of Vladimir Morozov (Russian Federation) from the International Civil Service Commission, effective 28 June 2010. Accordingly, the General Assembly will be required to appoint, at its current session, a person to fill the vacancy for the remaining period of the term of office of Mr. Morozov, which expires on 31 December 2012.
- 2. The Government of the Russian Federation has nominated Yevgeny Vladimirovich Afanasiev to fill the vacancy arising from the resignation of Mr. Morozov.
- 3. In a communication dated 12 July 2010, the Secretariat was informed by the Chair of the Group of Eastern European States that the candidature of Mr. Afanasiev has been endorsed by the Group.
- 4. The candidate's curriculum vitae is annexed to the present note.
