## **Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Committee on Contributions**

### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

*Rapporteur:* Ms. Nicole Ann **Mannion** (Ireland)

1. At its 28th meeting, on 7 March 2011, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/65/102/Rev.1/Add.1) concerning two vacancies in the membership of the Committee on Contributions as a result of the resignations of Mr. Richard Moon (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and Mr. Wu Gang (China). By that note, the Fifth Committee was informed of the nomination by the Government of the United Kingdom and endorsement by the Group of Western European and other States of Mr. Patrick Haughey (United Kingdom) to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Moon; and of the nomination by the Government of China and endorsement by the Group of Asian States of Mr. Sun Xudong (China) to fill the remainder of the term of office of Mr. Wu; both of which expire on 31 December 2011.

2. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Mr. Patrick Haughey and Mr. Sun Xudong as members of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on \_\_\_\_\_ 2011<sup>1</sup> and ending on 31 December 2011 (see para. 3 below).

### **Recommendation of the Fifth Committee**

3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint Mr. Patrick Haughey (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and Mr. Sun Xudong (China) as members of the Committee on Contributions for a term of office beginning on \_\_\_\_\_ 2011<sup>1</sup> and ending on 31 December 2011.
