Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 25th and 27th meetings, on 16 and 23 December 2010, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/65/10) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/65/L.48/Rev.1. At the 25th meeting, the Chair of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions introduced the related report of that Committee (A/65/613). The draft decision submitted by the Chair following informal consultations was before the Committee (see para. 3).

2. The statements and comments made in the course of the Fifth Committee's consideration of this question are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/65/SR.25 and 27).

Decision of the Fifth Committee

3. The Fifth Committee, having considered the statement of programme budget implications submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/65/10) and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/65/613), decides to inform the General Assembly that, should the Assembly adopt draft resolution A/C.3/65/L.48/Rev.1, additional resources would be required for the programme budget for the biennium 2010-2011 in the amount of \$1,216,700 under section 3, Political affairs, and \$154,200 under section 36, Staff assessment,



to be offset by the same amount under income section I, Income from staff assessment, for the continuation of the efforts of the good offices of the Secretary-General relating to the situation in Myanmar. The requirements have been included in the report of the Secretary-General on estimates in respect of special political missions, good offices and other political initiatives authorized by the Assembly and/or the Security Council (A/65/328 and Add.1 and Add.1/Corr.1 and 2).
