Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 20 September 2013, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-eighth session the item entitled “Appointments to fill vacancies in subsidiary organs and other appointments: appointment of members of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee” and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.

2. At its 14th meeting, on 1 November 2013, the Fifth Committee had before it the following documents:

(a) Note by the Secretary-General concerning the vacancies in the membership of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee that would occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of three of its members on 31 December 2013 ([A/68/106](#));

(b) Note by the Secretary-General containing the name of one person nominated for appointment to the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office¹ beginning on 1 January 2014 ([A/C.5/68/9](#)).

3. At the same meeting, the Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it appoint Natalia A. Bocharova (Russian Federation) as a member of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2014 (see para. 5).

4. The Committee also decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it postpone to a later date the appointment of two members to fill the remaining two vacancies.

¹ Members shall serve for three years and can be re-elected for a second and final term of three years.



Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

5. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly appoint Natalia A. Bocharova (Russian Federation) as a member of the Independent Audit Advisory Committee for a three-year term of office beginning on 1 January 2014.
