

# Financing of the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire

## Report of the Fifth Committee

#### I. Introduction

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2014, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-ninth session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 18th and resumed 27th meetings, on 4 and 29 December 2014. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/69/SR.18 and 27/Add.1).
- 3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:
- (a) Note by the Secretary-General on financing arrangements for the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire for the period from 1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015 (A/69/534 and Corr.1);
- (b) Related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/69/626).

## II. Consideration of draft resolution A/C.5/69/L.14

- 4. At its resumed 27th meeting, on 29 December 2014, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled "Financing of the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire" (A/C.5/69/L.14), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Israel.
- 5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft resolution A/C.5/69/L.14 without a vote (see para. 6).





## III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

### Financing of the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire

The General Assembly,

Having considered the note by the Secretary-General on the financing arrangements for the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

*Recalling* Security Council resolution 2162 (2014) of 25 June 2014, by which the Council extended the mandate of the Operation until 30 June 2015,

*Recalling also* its resolution 58/310 of 18 June 2004 on the financing of the Operation and its subsequent resolutions thereon, the latest of which was resolution 68/285 of 30 June 2014,

- 1. Decides, taking into account the amount of 246,785,150 United States dollars already apportioned under the terms of its resolution 68/285 for the maintenance of the Operation for the period from 1 July to 31 December 2014, to apportion among Member States the amount of 246,785,150 dollars for the maintenance of the Operation for the period from 1 January 2015 to 30 June 2015, in accordance with the levels updated in its resolution 67/239 of 24 December 2012 and taking into account the scale of assessments for 2015, as set out in its resolution 67/238 of 24 December 2012;
- 2. Also decides that, in accordance with the provisions of its resolution 973 (X) of 15 December 1955, there shall be set off against the apportionment among Member States, as provided for in paragraph 1 above, their respective share in the Tax Equalization Fund of 4,448,000 dollars, representing the estimated staff assessment income approved for the Operation for the period from 1 January to 30 June 2015;
- 3. *Further decides* to keep under review during its sixty-ninth session the item entitled "Financing of the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire".
