I. Introduction

- 1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2014, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-ninth session the item entitled "Administrative and budgetary coordination of the United Nations with the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency" and to allocate it to the Fifth Committee.
- 2. The Fifth Committee considered the item at its 3rd and resumed 27th meetings, on 8 October and 29 December 2014. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/69/SR.3 and 27/Add.1).
- 3. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system (A/69/305).

II. Consideration of draft decision A/C.5/69/L.23

- 4. At its resumed 27th meeting, on 29 December 2014, the Committee had before it a draft decision entitled "Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system" (A/C.5/69/L.23), submitted by the Chair of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representative of Hungary.
- 5. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted draft decision A/C.5/69/L.23 without a vote (see para. 6).





III. Recommendation of the Fifth Committee

6. The Fifth Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decision:

Budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system

The General Assembly:

(a) Takes note of the note by the Secretary-General transmitting the statistical report of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination on the budgetary and financial situation of the organizations of the United Nations system; ¹

(b) Decides to revert to the issue of the composition of the report.
