## **Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly**

### **Report of the First Committee**

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 19 September 2014, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to allocate item 118 to all the Main Committees for the sole purpose of considering and taking action on their respective tentative programmes of work for 2015.

2. The First Committee considered the item at its 25th meeting, on 15 June 2015 (see A/C.1/69/PV.25).

3. At its 25th meeting, the Committee decided to reconsider its provisional programme of work and timetable for 2015, adopted at its 24th meeting, on 4 November 2014, and subsequently adopted by the General Assembly in its decision 69/520 (see A/69/449/Rev.1).

4. At the same meeting, the Committee adopted its revised provisional programme of work and timetable for 2015, as set out in the annex to the present report.
