Summary

The present report contains information received from Member States on their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data are available. The Secretary-General has, to date, received reports from 37 Governments.

I. Introduction

1. The General Assembly, in paragraph 1 of its resolution 70/21, called upon Member States to report annually to the Secretary-General their military expenditures for the latest fiscal year for which data were available, using preferably — and to the extent possible — one of the standardized reporting forms, including a “nil report” form if appropriate.

II. Actions taken by the Secretariat

2. On 8 February 2016, the Office for Disarmament Affairs, in a note verbale, requested Member States to submit their reports no later than 29 April 2016. The replies received are reproduced in section III below (any additional reports received from Member States will be issued as an addendum to the present report).

3. The Office for Disarmament Affairs continues to maintain and update the online database for military expenditures (see www.un.org/disarmament/milex).

4. The Office for Disarmament Affairs has continued its efforts to promote the instrument among Member States, including through briefings and side events in the margins of the First Committee in 2015 and the Disarmament Commission, reminders, fact sheets and statistical updates.

5. The sharing of information on military expenditures is important for increasing trust between Governments in all parts of the world. However, having this information available is only the first step in confidence-building. As a follow-up measure, authorities from different countries may meet and discuss their respective military expenditures, for example, within their regional contexts. The Office for Disarmament Affairs stands ready to assist Member States and regional organizations, upon request, in making such confidence-building talks a reality.

III. Replies received from Governments

Explanatory notes

6. To date, the Secretary-General has received reports, on the basis of his request in 2016, from 37 Governments. A number of States provided clarifications and additional information on defence planning to explain their military expenditures, which are included in the present report as well.

7. The originals of the replies from States, if received by means other than the online reporting system, are available at the Office for Disarmament Affairs.

The White Paper on defence and national security, published on 29 April 2013, is an official public diplomacy and policy document that sets out the goals and principles of France's defence policy for the next 15 to 20 years. Based on an in-depth analysis of the strategic context, it establishes the framework (political, doctrinal, capabilities, legal, human and financial) for the activities of the armed forces in the years ahead.

As Europe's leading military power, France has decided to maintain a high level of political and military ambition through new operational contracts for the armed forces, commensurate with the risks and expected threats and with our country's major international responsibilities (vis-à-vis the United Nations and its alliances and defence agreements). To meet the ongoing imperative for strategic autonomy, the White Paper opts for a comprehensive military tool that covers the whole spectrum of military capabilities and guarantees autonomy of decision-making and action.

The resulting Act on military programming reflects the significant defence effort being maintained: 364 billion euros will be allocated to defence between 2014 and 2025, including 179.2 billion euros from 2014 to 2019. In the face of the deteriorating strategic context, and following up on the updates to the Act on military programming for the period 2014-2019 initiated at the request of the President of the Republic, the budgetary resources allocated to defence will be increased by 3.8 billion euros from 2015 to 2019. France, which today has the second largest military budget of the European Union, is therefore seeking to upgrade its military capabilities while also conducting many demanding operations to ensure its own security, that of its allies as well as international security.

These expenditures are entered for each force group in the United Nations Instrument as follows:

Strategic forces (column 1): these forces do not have a separate service or military department in the United States, therefore spending data are not readily available for them. All resources for strategic offensive, defensive and command, control and communications forces are contained in the budgets of the Air Force, Navy and Army.

Land forces (column 2): budget of the Department of the Army.

Naval forces (column 3): budget of the Department of the Navy, including the Navy and the Marine Corps.

Air forces (column 4): budget of the Department of the Air Force.

Other military forces (column 5): not applicable. All active and reserve military forces are financed from the above military service budgets.

Central support administration and command (column 6): the budgets of the defence agencies (Office of the Secretary of Defense, Defense Logistics Agency, Defense Information Systems Agency, Defense Contract Audit Agency, etc.) which provide defence-wide support and general administration.

United Nations peacekeeping (column 7): includes outlays for support of United Nations peacekeeping forces.

Military assistance and cooperation (column 8): includes foreign military financing, economic support fund and other programmes in the category “international security assistance”, budget of the United States Government, fiscal year 2015.

Emergency aid to civilians (column 9): included in the cost of total military forces; not separately provided.

Undistributed (column 10): Department of Energy, outlays of the National Nuclear Security Administration, environmental and other defence activities. Also includes Department of Homeland Security outlays for defence-related activities, including for Coast Guard operating expenses and infrastructure/acquisition/construction and improvements and for infrastructure protection and information security.

Civilian personnel (row 1.4): additional civilian pay in military construction, family housing, research, development, testing and evaluation, and revolving and management funds is ~30 per cent.

Military pensions (row 1.5): disbursements of military pensions, which are not disbursed by the Department of Defense, are not included in this report. However, the active military personnel and civilian personnel entries (rows 1.2 and 1.4) include accruals and the Government contribution to retirements for military personnel and civilian employees of the Department of Defense.

Nuclear warheads and bombs (row 3.1.3): all atomic energy defence activities, including weapons, materials production, naval reactor development and verification and control technology.

Construction (row 3.2): includes the cost of defence family housing.
