Report of the Commission of Inquiry on Burundi

Note by the Secretariat

By its resolution 33/24, adopted on 30 September 1966, the Human Rights Council created the Commission of Inquiry on Burundi, inter alia:

- (a) To conduct a thorough investigation into human rights violations and abuses in Burundi since April 2015, including on their extent and whether they may constitute international crimes;
- (b) To identify alleged perpetrators of those crimes;
- (c) To present its report to the General Assembly and other relevant international bodies.

Pursuant to the resolution, the final report of the Commission will be contained in document [A/HRC/36/54](#), which will be submitted to the Human Rights Council at its thirty-sixth session, to be held in September 2017.
