Letter dated 3 April 2018 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Chile to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to refer to document A/72/797, through which was circulated today, as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 31, 84 and 120, the so-called "Declaration 15th ALBA-TCP Summit, Caracas, March 5th, 2018".

Chile would like to place on record that the above-mentioned declaration is not a document negotiated and approved in the United Nations system and it cannot be opposable to any United Nations State Member. Likewise, my delegation objects to any reference to this declaration in any United Nations document or in the context of current and future processes, discussions, negotiations, reports or resolutions.

I would be grateful to have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 31, 84 and 120.
