PRELIMINARY MEETING ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AGENCY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA

Mexico City, 28 June 1969

No. 20078 Sir.

At a meeting held yesterday, 27 June 1969, the Preliminary Meeting on the establishment of the Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America unanimously adopted resolution 5, entitled "Transmission of the Final Act to the United Nations", the text of which is as follows:

"The Preliminary Meeting on the establishment of the Agency for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America,

"Decides:

"To request the Chairman of the Meeting to transmit to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the text of the Final Act of the Meeting, with the request that he circulate it as a General Assembly document for the information of Members of the Organization and in connexion with resolutions 1911 (XVIII), 2286 (XXIII) and 2456 B (XXIII)."

In compliance with the above resolution, I have the honour to transmit to you five copies of the Final Act.

I take this opportunity to renew the assurances of my highest consideration.
