Appointment of two members of the Special Committee against Apartheid

(Item 37)

By a letter dated 19 March 1975,5 the President of the General Assembly informed the Secretary-General that, having held the consultations called for in paragraph 12 of Assembly resolution 3324 D (XXIX) of 16 December 1974, he had appointed the following two members of the Special Committee against Apartheid: GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and INDONESIA.

As a result, the Special Committee is composed of the following Member States: ALGERIA, GERMAN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC, GHANA, GUINEA, HAITI, HUN-GARY, INDIA, INDONESIA, MALAYSIA, NEPAL, NIGERIA, PERU, PHILIPPINES, SOMALIA, SUDAN, SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC, TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO and UKRAINIAN SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLIC.

Appointment of the members of the Group of Experts on the Draft Convention on Territorial Asylum

(Item 59)

Appointment of the members of the **Committee on Conferences**
