The Permanent Mission of Peru to the United Nations (Vienna), in accordance with article 5, paragraph 1, of the Agreement on the Rescue of Astronauts, the Return of Astronauts and the Return of Objects Launched into Outer Space (General Assembly resolution 2345 (XXII), annex) has the honour to inform the Secretary-General of the discovery of five space objects that fell to Earth in its territory on 27 January 2018 (see annex).

The investigations conducted by the National Aerospace Research and Development Commission (CONIDA) revealed that one of the objects found in the Department of Puno, in southern Peru, bore inscriptions in Russian. It should be noted that the objects referred to above are currently in the possession of CONIDA, in its capacity as the national space agency of Peru.
