CONTRIBUTIONS PLEDGED AT THE ELEVENTH UNITED NATIONS PLEDGING CONFERENCE FOR THE UNITED NATIONS DISARMAMENT INFORMATION PROGRAMME AND THEREAFTER UNTIL 31 MARCH 1994

- 1. In the Final Act of the Eleventh United Nations Pledging Conference for the United Nations Disarmament Information Programme (A/CONF.170/1), the Secretary-General was requested to maintain, until 31 March 1994, a list incorporating pledges made or announced at the Conference and those made thereafter until that date, and to issue that list as part of the records of the Conference.
- 2. The present document is issued pursuant to that request.
