The Deputy Secretary-General of the International Telecommunication Union stated that his organization enjoyed a close working relationship with the national and international scientific communities, exchanging and contributing the results of their investigations to permit the orderly adaptation of scientific and technological progress to world telecommunication systems. He referred to disparities and obstacles in telecommunication development and emphasized the need to follow policies in the national determination of investment priorities which would directly support development and other essential specialized projects such as improved health care, human settlement and the transfer of information. The development of satellite communications was revolutionizing historical investment policies, since they were cost-insensitive to distance. Coupled with other technical developments, with the advantages of dramatic cost reductions and with international collaboration and shared facilities, the use of telecommunications could be organized quickly for the rural and isolated areas at an acceptable cost. These possibilities were receiving detailed study in ITU and were of considerable importance in connexion with the Programme of Action of the Conference.
