At its 4th meeting, on 14 July 2020, the open-ended intergovernmental meeting continued the discussion of the draft self-assessment questionnaires – Cluster I and II and also discussed the outstanding issues in the draft self-assessment questionnaires – Cluster III and IV. During this meeting, the discussion of all outstanding issues was finalized with the exception of questions 71 and 72 in Cluster I relating to the Protocol against the Illicit Manufacturing of and Trafficking in Firearms, Their Parts and Components and Ammunition. The draft self-assessment questionnaires for the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime, for the Protocol against the Smuggling of Migrants by Land, Sea and Air, and the Protocol to Prevent, Suppress and Punish Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children were finalized for submission and consideration by the Conference of the Parties at its tenth session.
