III. Summary of deliberations (*continued*)

1. On its second day, the open-ended intergovernmental meeting continued examining the draft procedures and rules for the review mechanism. Views were exchanged on the following main issues, in addition to what was discussed during the previous day: the structure, length and format of the outcome of the reviews, including different proposals as to the exact form the outcome should take and the role of the secretariat in this regard; the question of confidentiality of the information provided by States parties under review and the availability of some information, including through the SHERLOC portal; the timelines for the completion of the different stages of the review; and the role of the working groups of the Conference in assisting the Conference in its review of the Convention and the Protocols thereto.
