Report on the meeting of the Expert Group to Conduct a Comprehensive Study on Cybercrime held in Vienna from 6 to 8 April 2021

Note by the Secretariat

1. In its resolution 26/4, entitled "Strengthening international cooperation to combat cybercrime", the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice encouraged the open-ended intergovernmental Expert Group to Conduct a Comprehensive Study on Cybercrime to develop possible conclusions and recommendations for submission to the Commission.

2. The seventh meeting of the Expert Group was held in Vienna from 6 to 8 April 2021. At the extended Bureau meeting held on 31 March 2021, it was agreed that the report on the meeting would be a procedural report and would not include a Chair's summary of deliberations, and that it would have an annex containing the conclusions and recommendations.

3. That report, as contained in document UNODC/CCPCJ/EG.4/2021/2, is being brought to the attention of the Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice for its consideration.
