Given the extent of the work to be accomplished in developing Asia's transport infrastructure, focusing on the promotion of selected international corridors, including Euro-Asian transport linkages, is a practical means of developing the transport network.

## 2. Paragraph 55

Replace the second sentence with the following:
One approach to this is to focus efforts on a set of strategic international corridors, including Euro-Asian transport linkages, that integrate the Asian Highway, Trans-Asian Railway and other modes of transport through dry ports, identify the issues and challenges on these corridors, then make concerted efforts to fully operationalize the corridors by removing the various physical and non-physical barriers.
