This is the fourth and final annual report of the Executive Director on progress towards achieving the organizational priorities of the UNICEF medium-term plan for 1998-2001 (E/ICEF/1998/13 and Corr.1), as requested by the Executive Board at its January 1999 session (E/ICEF/1999/7/Rev.1, decision 1999/7). It covers activities and developments during 2001, in addition to income and expenditure, including resource mobilization, and performance management. A series of annexes provide detailed information on programmatic and operational results achieved during the year, as well as financial information.

4. Summary of mid-term reviews and major evaluations of country programmes

These reports were prepared in response to Executive Board decision 1995/8 (E/ICEF/1995/9/Rev.1), adopted at the first regular session of 1995, in which the secretariat was requested to submit to the Board a summary of the outcome of MTRs and major country programme evaluations, specifying, inter alia, results achieved, lessons learned and the need for any adjustment in the country note.

The reports cover Eastern and Southern Africa (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.17); West and Central Africa (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.18); Americas and the Caribbean (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.19); East Asia and the Pacific (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.20); South Asia (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.21); Middle East and North Africa (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.22); and Central and Eastern Europe, the Commonwealth of Independent States and the Baltic States (E/ICEF/2002/P/L.23). Each report will be introduced by the respective regional director.

5. Report on the evaluation function in the context of the medium-term strategic plan

In approving the programme of work for its sessions in 2002 (E/ICEF/2001/6/Rev.1, decision 2001/23), the Executive Board requested the secretariat to prepare a report on the evaluation function in the context of the MTSP for 2002-2005 (E/ICEF/2001/13 and Corr.1). This report, which contains a draft recommendation for Board approval, responds to that request.
