NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 97th plenary meeting of its thirty-ninth session, on 12 December 1984, the General Assembly adopted resolution 39/62, entitled "Prohibition of the development and manufacture of new types of weapons of mass destruction and new systems of such weapons". 1/

2. In paragraph 3 of that resolution, the General Assembly:

"Calls upon the States permanent members of the Security Council as well as upon other militarily significant States to make declarations, identical in substance, concerning the refusal to create new types of weapons of mass destruction and new systems of such weapons, as a first step towards the conclusion of a comprehensive agreement on this subject, bearing in mind that such declarations would be approved thereafter by a decision of the Security Council".
