NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

1. At the 102nd plenary meeting of its thirty-ninth session, on 17 December 1984, the General Assembly adopted resolution 39/156, entitled "Strengthening of international security: common security". 1/

2. In paragraphs 8 and 9 of that resolution, the General Assembly:

"8. Encourages the Security Council, subject to its own priorities, to intensify its efforts in the prevention of international conflict and the peaceful settlement of disputes by envisaging, if possible, a more systematic series of meetings under the agreed five main aspects mentioned in paragraph 2 of the note of the President of the Council dated 12 September 1983; 2/

"9. Welcomes further information from the Security Council on the progress achieved, at periodic intervals, as deemed appropriate."
