This report, the twelfth since the establishment of the United Nations Multidimensional Integrated Stabilization Mission in Mali (MINUSMA), summarizes the actions undertaken between 1 March and 1 June 2016 by French forces in support of MINUSMA.

Since 1 March 2016, no action has been undertaken in response to an imminent and serious threat.
