Identical letters dated 20 April 2017 from the Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

Upon instruction from my Government, I have the honour to attach herewith a list detailing the numbers of civilians killed or injured, in addition to losses inflicted on infrastructure and public and private property, by mortar shells launched by terrorist armed groups against peaceful neighbourhoods and civilians in the city of Damascus and its suburbs, during the period from 8 to 16 April 2017.
