


Information note regarding the detection of the launch of a ballistic missile by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea

On 4 July 2017, a Voronezh-type radar station in the Irkutsk region tracked the launch from the Tongchang-dong launch site (100 kilometres north-west of Pyongyang) of a Hwasong-class intermediate-range ballistic missile (see enclosure).

The missile remained in flight for approximately 14 minutes, reaching a maximum altitude of 535 kilometres and travelling a distance of 510 kilometres. It fell into the Sea of Japan.
