

Letter dated 27 July 2017 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 2362 (2017), adopted by the Security Council on 29 June 2017, by which the Council decided to extend, until 15 November 2018, the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya established pursuant to resolution 1973 (2011).

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1970 (2011) concerning Libya, I have appointed the following experts:

Kassim Bouhou, armed groups expert (France)

Luis Antonio de Alburquerque Bacardit, maritime/transport expert (Spain)

Moncef Kartas, arms expert (Tunisia)

Lipika Majumdar Roy Choudhury, finance expert (India)

David McFarland, arms expert (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)

I have also designated Ms. Majumdar Roy Choudhury to serve as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
