Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

Over the past 24 hours, the Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has not reported any violations.

The Turkish representative office has reported five violations in the following governorates: three in Damascus, one in Idlib and one in Ladhikiyah.

Most of the incidents of small arms being fired indiscriminately have been reported in areas controlled by fighters of the terrorist groups Nusra Front and Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIL).

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides has not carried out any humanitarian operations.

No medical assistance has been provided over the past 24 hours.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out one humanitarian operation in Ayn al-Karm in Ladhikiyah governorate, where a total of 0.9 tons of food was delivered to the local population.

In total, 1,612 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,160.4 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 66 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 56,748 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah governorates.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 17 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 56,765 residents.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 326 residents.

In total, 1,617 humanitarian operations have been carried out. The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,167.7 tons.

The United Nations carried out two humanitarian operations: a total of 60 tons of food and medicine was delivered to Dar'a governorate.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 79 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 57,197 residents.

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed with populated areas.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.
