Information bulletin from the Russian Federation Ministry of Defence regarding the status of implementation of the memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas (22 September 2017)

Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported seven incidents of gunfire in the following governorates: three in Dar'a, two in Damascus and two in Ladhqiyyah.

The Turkish representative office has reported six violations in the following governorates: two in Damascus, two in Idlib, one in Aleppo and one in Dar'a.

Most of the incidents of small arms being fired indiscriminately have been reported in areas controlled by fighters of the terrorist groups Nusra Front and Islamic State in Iraq and the Levant (ISIL).

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out three humanitarian operations: the delivery of 1.6 tons of food to the local population of Na'im in Homs governorate; the delivery of 2.2 tons of food to the local population of Tall Abu Susa in Aleppo governorate; and the delivery of 1.4 tons of food to the local population of Dar'a in Dar'a governorate.

In total, 1,620 humanitarian operations have been carried out.

The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,172.9 tons.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 285 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 57,482 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime have continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 233.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has not carried out any humanitarian operations.

The United Nations has carried out one humanitarian operation: food, medicine and household supplies with a total weight of 225 tons were delivered to Mudayra in Damascus governorate.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 60 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 57,542 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime have continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah governorates.

Over the past 24 hours, one application form has been signed with the leader of an illegal armed group operating in de-escalation area No. 1.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire has increased to 234.

Observance of the ceasefire regime

Monitoring groups have continued to monitor observance of the ceasefire regime as part of implementing the memorandum on the creation of de-escalation areas in the Syrian Arab Republic, signed by the Russian Federation, the Republic of Turkey and the Islamic Republic of Iran on 4 May 2017.

The situation in the de-escalation areas has been assessed as stable.

The Russian representative office of the Russian and Turkish Joint Commission reviewing issues related to violations of the ceasefire regime has reported 13 incidents of gunfire in the following governorates: 4 in Damascus, 4 in Hama, 3 in Homs, 1 in Dar'a and 1 in Ladhikiyah.

The Turkish representative office has reported two violations in Damascus governorate.

Most of the incidents of small arms being fired indiscriminately have been reported in areas controlled by fighters of the terrorist groups Nusra Front and ISIL.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out two humanitarian operations: school supplies were delivered to the local population of Kafr Nasih and Ahras.

In total, 1,622 humanitarian operations have been carried out.

The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,173.2 tons.

The United Nations has carried out one humanitarian operation: food, medicine and household supplies with a total weight of 225 tons were delivered to Mudayra in Damascus governorate.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 45 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 57,587 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime have continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.

Provision of humanitarian aid to the population of the Syrian Arab Republic

Over the past 24 hours, the Centre for Reconciliation of Opposing Sides in the Syrian Arab Republic has carried out three humanitarian operations: food with a total weight of 6 tons was delivered to the local population of Dary al-Fardis in Homs governorate; and food with a total weight of 3 tons was delivered to the local population of Tall Rif'at and Dayr Jamal in Aleppo governorate.

In total, 1,625 humanitarian operations have been carried out.

The total weight of humanitarian cargo delivered is 2,182.2 tons.

The United Nations has dispatched two humanitarian convoys: food and medicine with a total weight of 115 tons were delivered to Tayyibah and Tall Shihab in Dar'a governorate.

Over the past 24 hours, medical assistance has been provided to 24 residents.

In total, medical assistance has been provided to 57,611 residents.

Reconciliation of opposing sides

Over the past 24 hours, no ceasefire agreements have been signed.

The number of populated areas that have joined the reconciliation process is unchanged — it is still 2,235.

Negotiations on joining the ceasefire regime have continued with armed opposition groups in Aleppo, Damascus, Hama, Homs and Qunaytirah governorates.

The number of armed groups that have announced their commitment to accepting and fulfilling the terms of the ceasefire is unchanged — it is still 234.
