Identical letters dated 27 March 2018 from the Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

Following the previous letters that I have addressed to you regarding the repeated and continuing terrorist attacks by armed terrorist groups on the city of Damascus and its suburbs, and upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to submit herewith a table clarifying the numbers of civilians killed and injured as a result of rocket-propelled grenades and mortar shells launched by armed terrorist groups against safe neighbourhoods in Damascus and its suburbs on 23, 24 and 25 March 2018. These terrorist attacks have killed and wounded dozens of civilians, mostly children, and caused serious damage to public and private properties and infrastructure.
