Letter dated 2 June 2020 from the President of the Security Council addressed to the Permanent Representatives of the members of the Security Council

As France assumes the presidency of the Security Council on 1 June, the restrictions imposed by the Governor of New York State in relation to coronavirus disease (COVID-19) are still in place, and the measures issued by the Secretary-General aimed at limiting the presence of United Nations staff within the United Nations premises are in place until 30 June.

Accordingly, after consultation with the Secretariat and all members of the Council, the French presidency will continue to implement the guidelines agreed upon under previous presidencies, which are set out in the letter dated 7 May 2020 from the President of the Council addressed to the Permanent Representatives of the members of the Council ($\frac{S}{2020}/372$).

The guidelines are a response to the current exceptional and unprecedented circumstances.

The guidelines will be assessed at the end of June and may be reviewed, adjusted or discontinued, subject to the agreement of all members.
