Letter dated 14 May 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution [2571 \(2021\)](#), adopted on 16 April 2021, by which the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on Libya until 15 August 2022.

Mr. Adrian Wilkinson, arms (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland)

I have designated Ms. Aoun to serve as Coordinator of the Panel.
