Letter dated 12 August 2021 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to the letter dated 22 July 2021 from the President of the Security Council (S/2021/675) concurring with my proposal to appoint Ms. Fatimata Sanou Touré (Burkina Faso) as a judge of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals to replace Judge Gberdao Gustave Kam, who passed away on 17 February 2021.

I have received a corresponding letter from the President of the General Assembly (see annex). Accordingly, I am proceeding to appoint Ms. Sanou Touré as a judge of the Mechanism with immediate effect.

In accordance with article 10, paragraph 2, of the statute of the Mechanism, the appointment of Ms. Sanou Touré is effective for the remainder of the term of office that Judge Kam would have served, that is, until 30 June 2022.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
