

Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006)

Note verbale dated 1 November 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Liechtenstein to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1718 (2006) concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and has the honour to refer to Security Council resolutions 2371 (2017), adopted on 5 August 2017, and 2375 (2017), adopted on 11 September 2017, in which the Council called upon all States to report on the implementation of those resolutions.

On 22 August and 24 October 2017 the Government of Liechtenstein amended the Government Ordinance on Measures concerning the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (Liechtenstein Legal Gazette 2017, Nos. 214 and 295) with a view to implementing the United Nations sanctions established in Security Council resolutions 2371 (2017) and 2375 (2017). Liechtenstein has fully implemented the measures contained in those resolutions. Violations are punishable in accordance with criminal law. The above-mentioned Ordinance is regularly updated following relevant decisions by the sanctions Committee.

Implementation is smooth and does not currently pose any particular difficulty. The Government of Liechtenstein is fully committed to maintaining the high level of implementation and to keeping the measures taken under review, as necessary.
