Report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force for the period from 23 February to 23 May 2018 (S/2018/550)

Members of the Council have before them document S/2018/647, which contains the text of a draft resolution submitted by the Russian Federation and the United States of America.
