Amendment to the Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2011/3 on the Management Committee

The Secretary-General, for the purpose of amending the composition of the Management Committee, promulgates the following:

Section 2.1 of the Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2011/3 is replaced by the following text:

"2.1 The Management Committee shall be chaired by the Chef de Cabinet, on behalf of the Secretary-General. Its members shall consist of the Special Adviser on Change Implementation, Assistant Secretary-General for Strategic Planning, Under-Secretary-General for Management, Under-Secretary-General for Field Support, Assistant Secretary-General for Human Resources Management, Assistant Secretary-General for Programme Planning, Budget and Accounts/the Controller, Assistant Secretary-General for Central Support Services, Assistant Secretary-General for Information and Communications Technology/Chief Information Technology Officer, Assistant Secretary-General for the Enterprise Resource Planning Project, Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs, Under-Secretary-General for General Assembly and Conference Management, Under-Secretary-General for Legal Affairs/the Legal Counsel, Assistant Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations and Assistant Secretary-General for Political Affairs, 1 as well as the Coordinator of the Regional Commissions and the Directors-General of the United Nations Office at Geneva, the United Nations Office at Nairobi and the United Nations Office at Vienna."

The present amendment shall enter into force on the date of its issuance.
