## 71/88. Implementation of the new common system compensation package in the United Nations Secretariat

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 70/244 of 23 December 2015,

Having considered the notes by the Secretary-General on the implementation of the new common system compensation package in the United Nations Secretariat<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

- 1. Takes note of the notes by the Secretary-General; 1
- 2. Expresses serious concern that the Secretary-General failed to provide Member States with timely information on possible delays in, and resource requirements for, the implementation of elements of the new compensation package for staff in the Professional and higher categories as approved by the General Assembly in its resolution 70/244;
- 3. *Decides* that the Secretary-General, in implementing the new common system compensation package, absorb all additional requirements from within existing resources, as described in the note by the Secretary-General.<sup>3</sup>
