## 航空旅行舱位标准

## 秘书长的报告

## 摘要

秘书长关于航空旅行舱位标准的本报告是根据大会第 42/214、45/248 A、53/214、63/268、65/268、67/254 A 和 69/274 A 号决议及第 44/442、46/450 和 57/589 号决定提交的，其中大会请秘书长每两年向其提出一份报告。本报告提供资料，说明了 2016 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期的航空旅行舱位标准、2014 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期的比较统计数据以及过去十年趋势分析。

报告还按照大会第 67/254 A 和 69/274 A 号决议的要求，提供了一些有关航空旅行具体事项的资料。



## 一. 导言

1. 联合国航空旅行舱位标准必须遵守大会一系列决议和决定，包括第 [42/214](#)、[45/248 A](#)、[53/214](#)、[63/268](#)、[65/268](#)、[67/254 A](#) 和 [69/274 A](#) 号决议及第 44/442、46/450 和 57/589 号决定。根据授予秘书长按照具体情况核准航空旅行舱位标准的例外的酌处权，秘书长颁布了 [ST/AI/2013/3](#)，Amend.1 和 Amend.2 号行政指示，以便于执行有关航空旅行舱位标准及其例外的各项工作人员细则。
2. 过去对这些标准的几类例外作出规定，包括但不限于以下情况：知名人士旅行；杰出人士旅行；在认为属于在艰苦情况下旅行时，或在此情况下由于健康原因而认为适宜航空旅行舱位升级的旅行；随同秘书长、常务副秘书长及其配偶旅行的安保人员；随同大会主席旅行的安保人员；在没有常规标准旅行舱位的情况下，认为适合核准升级的旅行。
3. 大会第 [67/254 A](#) 号决议决定，对于低于助理秘书长职等的公务旅行者，如果单段行程的时间为九小时或以上，或如果多段行程的时间为 11 小时或以上，包括最多两小时转机时间，航空旅行舱位标准则为商务舱，但前提是前往下一个目的地的旅程在 12 小时内继续。大会还请秘书长修改其关于航空旅行舱位标准的行政指示，应根据已有的最经济航线确定旅程的持续时间，但前提是整个旅程的全部额外时间不会比最直接的航线多出四小时。在遵守大会第 [67/254 A](#) 号决议规定的前提下，大会还核可了行政和预算问题咨询委员会题为“关于提高利用航空旅行资源的成效和效率的提案”的报告([A/66/739](#))和题为“航空旅行舱位标准”的报告([A/67/636](#))中所载的大多数结论和建议，其中包括规定经济舱是咨询人和个体订约人员航空旅行的舱位标准，除非秘书长考虑到旅行者的情况(即健康原因和本组织的利益)另行作出决定。在这方面，主管管理事务副秘书长颁布了关于公务旅行的 [ST/AI/2013/3](#)，Amend.1 和 Amend.2 号行政指示，其中纳入了大会的各项决定。行政指示还根据大会第 [67/254 A](#) 号决议第六节第 20 段的规定，对所有其他获准的联合国旅行者的旅行应享待遇旅费作出更改，但该政策明确排除的旅行者除外。
4. 在同一决议中，大会注意到出现航空旅行舱位标准的例外情况日益频繁，费用也有所增加，因此请秘书长采取行动限制使用例外，分析使用例外的趋势，在大会第六十九届会议之前提出关于加强这方面控制措施的建议。大会还请秘书长审查杰出人员类别使用例外的情况并就此提交报告。由于需要更多时间审查这一事项，秘书长请求在大会第七十三届会议第一期续会期间提交他的建议。
5. 第二、第三和第四节详细分析和说明了不同类别的例外数量和有关额外费用的变动情况。

6. 大会第 69/274 A 号决议第四节请秘书长：(a) 向大会报告在使用飞行常客里程方面的任何新趋势，以改善差旅问题的行政管理；(b) 提供最新的详细情况，说明内部监督事务厅关于对所有航空旅行活动及有关做法的全面审计(A/67/695)所载建议的执行情况；(c) 提交关于航空旅行活动的全面信息；(d) 提交关于通过执行第 67/254 A 号决议第六节所取得的成果的综合数据；(e) 提交关于在旅行行政管理方面执行“团结”系统的影响的全面资料，包括与联合国航空旅行有关的所有领域的最新资料、趋势和分析；(f) 对联合国航空旅行等级的舱位标准的评估。秘书长已在本报告第五至十节报告了这些事项。

7. 大会赞同行政和预算问题咨询委员会的报告(A/69/787)中的建议，请秘书长进一步分析一次总付办法，并在本报告中提出更新提议。由于需要额外时间审查这一事项，秘书长提议，在向大会第七十三届会议第一部分续会将提交最后提议之前，继续将一笔总付款额保持在限制最少的经济舱票价的 70%。

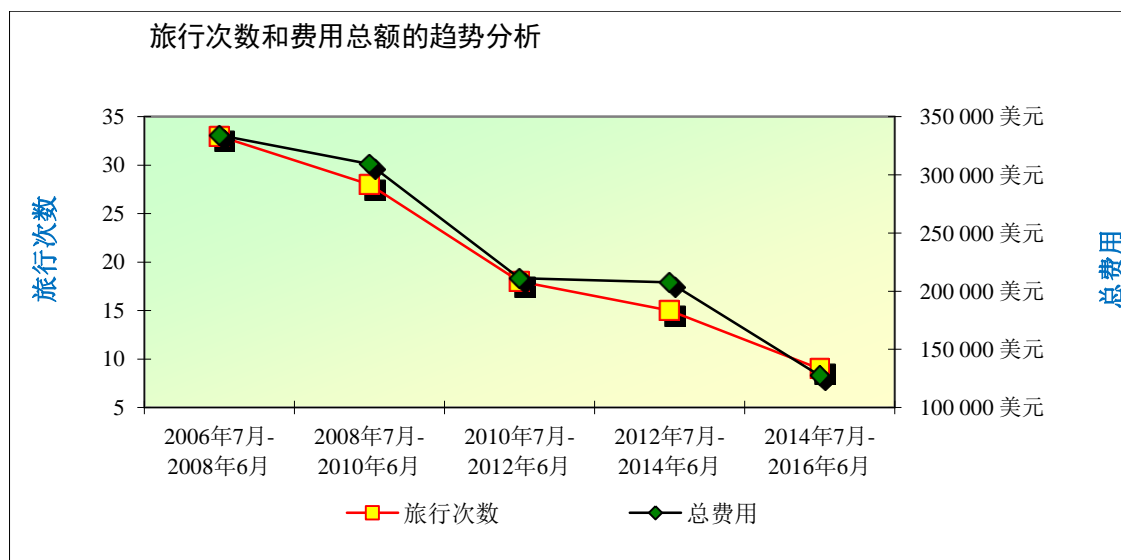
## 二. 代表团的旅行

8. 根据大会第 42/214 号决议，航空旅行头等舱位费用的支付仅限于最不发达国家代表团团长前往出席大会常会和特别会议。在 2014 年 7 月 1 日至 2016 年 6 月 30 日期间，核准了 9 次头等舱旅行，费用为 127 600 美元，而 2012 年 7 月 1 日至 2014 年 6 月 30 日期间共有 15 次旅行，费用为 207 673 美元。

9. 如图一所示，由于从最不发达国家收到的请求越来越少，大会代表的旅行次数以及大会代表旅费的总费用一直在减少。

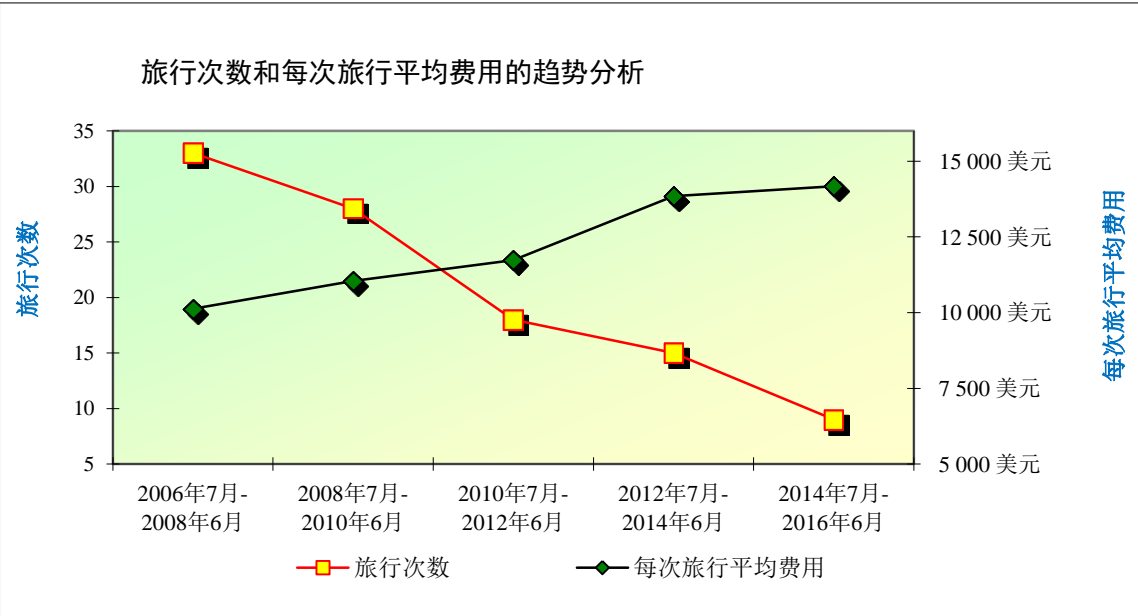

10. 如图二所示,每次旅行的平均费用从2006年7月至2008年6月期间的10 124美元逐步增至2014年7月至2016年6月期间的14 178美元。这一状况符合全球业界头等舱机票价格上涨的趋势。

代表乘坐头等舱前往出席大会届会的情况

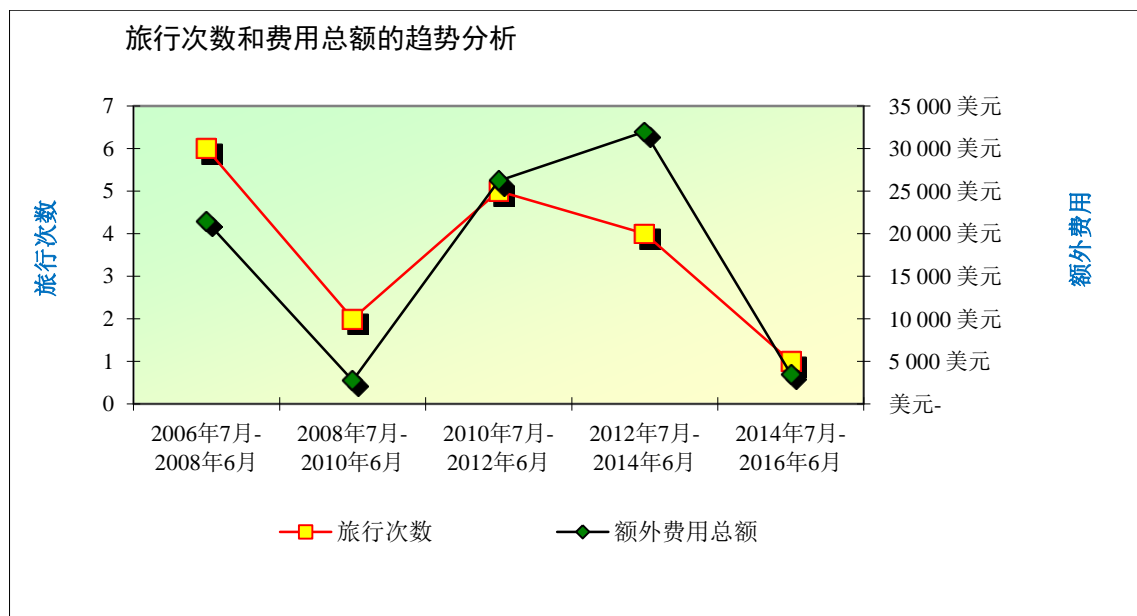


三. 大会主席的旅行

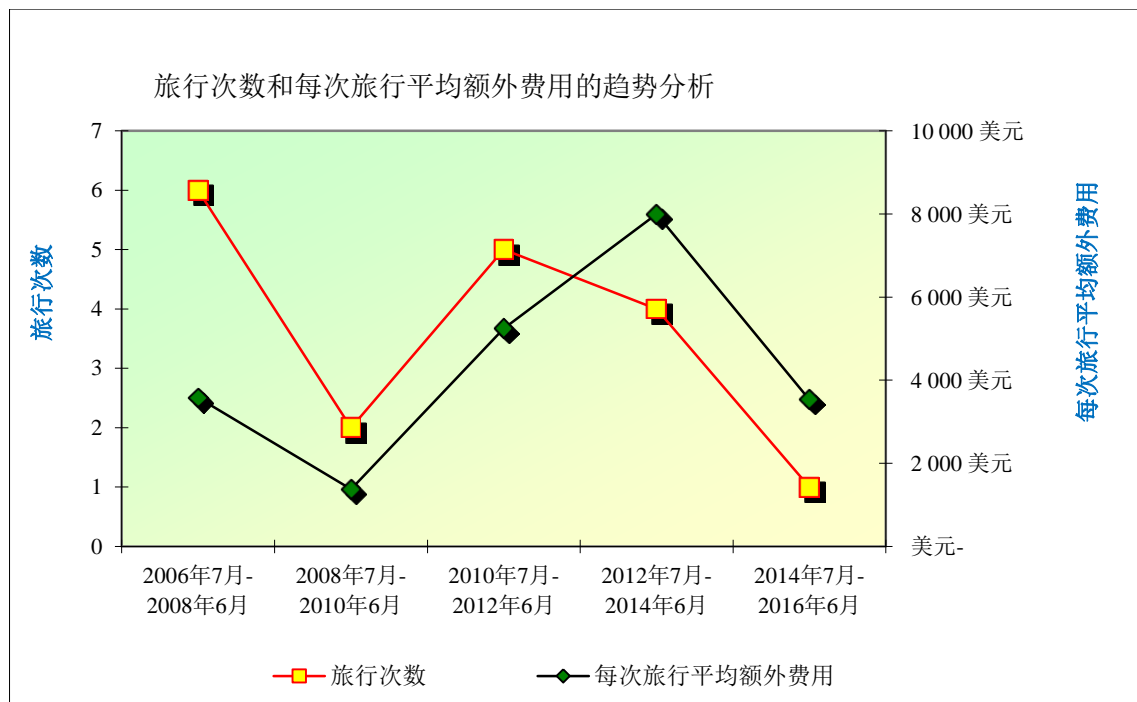
11. 为了加强大会主席切实有效地履行主席职责的能力,大会第 53/214 号决议决定,大会主席在符合核定方案预算的情况下,有充分权力使用预算给予其办公室的资金。2014年7月至2016年6月,在2016年6月30日终了两年期间只有一次头等舱旅行,产生的额外费用为3 534美元;相比之下,在2014年6月30日终了两年期间进行了四次旅行,产生的额外费用为31 983美元。本报告附件六载有大会主席核准的头等舱旅行的详细资料。

12. 大会主席由经常预算供资的头等舱旅行次数从2006年7月至2008年6月期间的6次稳步减少到2014年7月至2016年6月期间的仅一次。在2016年6月30日终了的报告所述期间,每次旅行的额外费用减少到3 534美元,而上一个报告所述期间为7 996美元。其原因是,每次旅行的行程比上一个报告所述期间的四次旅行要短(见图三和图四)。

## 四. 秘书长核准的例外

13. 大会第 42/214 号决议授权秘书长行使其酌处权，根据具体情况允许头等舱航空旅行。此外，在秘书长认为因特殊情况而有理由允许航空旅行舱位标准例外的情况下，还可根据 ST/AI/2013/3 号行政指示第 4.8 节行使这一酌处权。秘书长在行使这项权力时，除其他外考虑到以下情况：

(a) 仅在在有理由预期，较低等级的旅行会对旅行者的健康造成直接、严重的有害影响时，才应以健康原因为由提出旅行升级请求。应首先将所有这些请求提交给医务司司长，并且必须附上足够的文件，向秘书长满意地证明，旅行升级将防止发生这种伤害。仅年事已高并不被视为给予例外的充分理由；

(b) 由于服务紧急需要，旅行者可能必须在特定日期旅行，而当时并没有常规标准的航空旅行舱位。如果没有可以提供常规标准舱位的航班，以及如果旅行者等待下一个可用航班，每日生活津贴费用将高于较高标准舱位的费用，也可能发生这种情况。秘书长有权酌情根据具体情况决定，这些因素是否属于 ST/AI/2013/3, Amend.1 和 Amend.2 号行政指示所指的“特殊情况”；

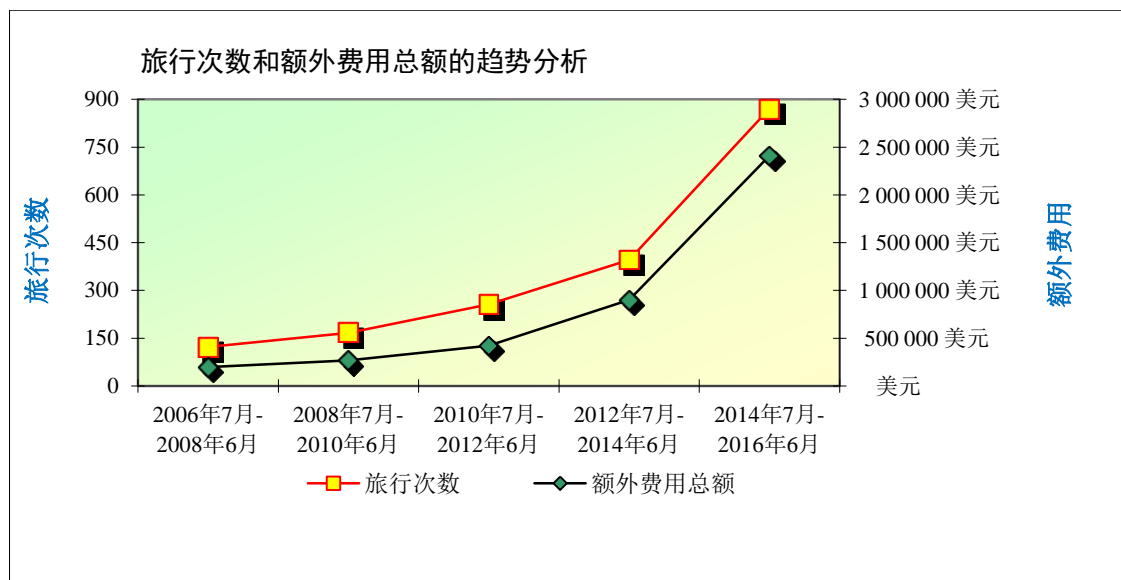
(c) 如果旅行者是现任或前任国家元首或政府首脑，则被视为知名人士；

(d) 如果旅行者是现任或前任内阁部长，或秘书长认为旅行者是在政治、科学、经济、人道主义和文化领域的重要国际人物，并正在为本组织提供服务，则被视为杰出人士；

(e) 如旅行者在完成一整天的工作后，因服务紧急需要而必须连夜旅行，以便在次日上午或在抵达后立即继续工作和/或参加在另一地点举行的重要会议，这种情况可被认为是艰苦旅程。但是，不妨通过事先作出适当旅行规划，避免这种情况的发生。秘书长有权针对每一种具体情况，酌情决定相关因素是否属于 ST/AI/2013/3, Amend.1 和 Amend.2 号行政指示所指的“特殊情况”。

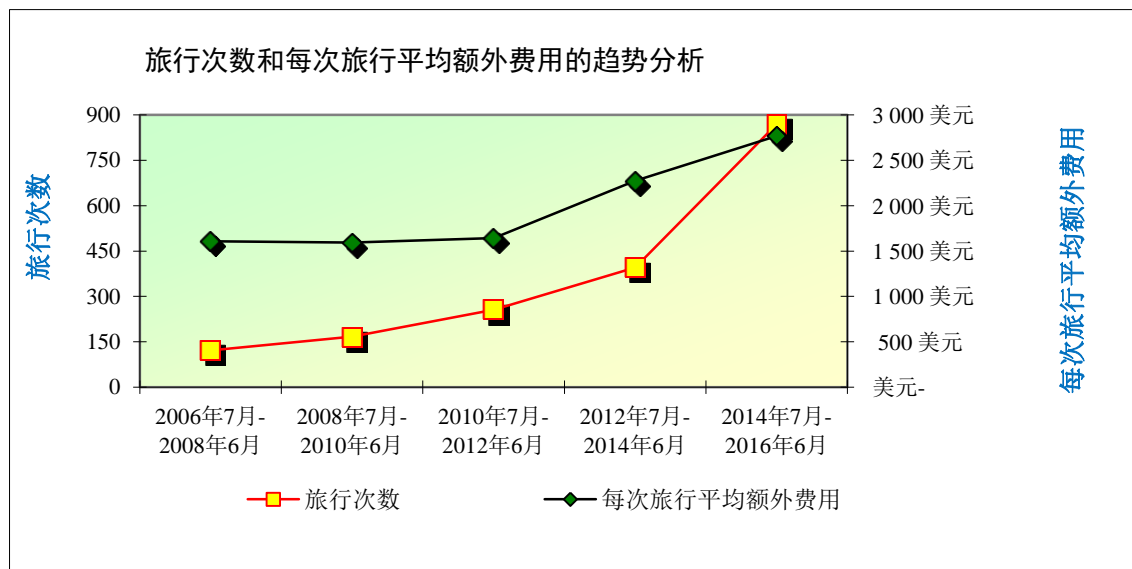
14. 如图五所示，秘书长为联合国秘书处核准的例外旅行次数和额外费用总额额外费用总额逐步增加。ST/AI/2013/3 号文件颁布后，增加了旅行者有资格乘坐商务舱所需的时间，并把经济舱作为咨询人、个体订约人员和向本组织提供服务的其他非工作人员的航空旅行舱位标准，因此，在 2014 年 7 月至 2016 年 6 月期间提出了更多的例外请求，特别是为杰出人士类别提出的请求。许多杰出人士通过以下方式向本组织提供服务：参加实质性会议；担任技术和咨询委员会成员；在高级别小组向本组织提供免费投入。必须指出的是，在某些情况下，以往的旅行政策并不把杰出人士看作是例外，因为杰出人士有资格享有与工作人员相同的舱位标准。

为联合国秘书处核准的例外



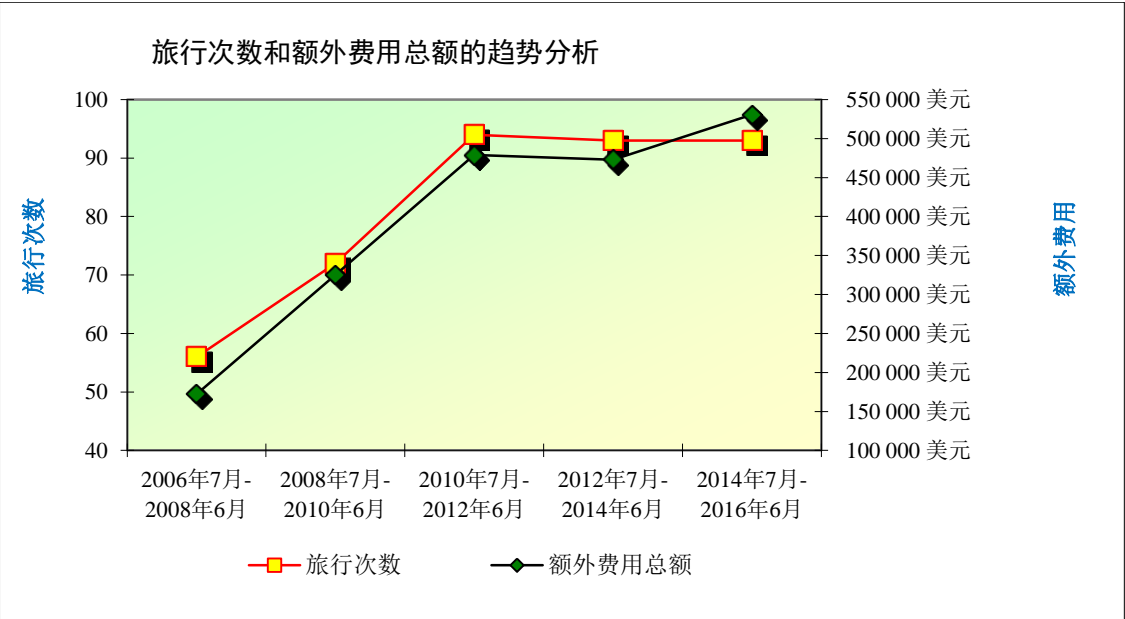
15. 图六显示，在 2014 年 7 月至 2016 年 6 月所述期间，联合国秘书处每次旅行平均额外费用增加到 2 769 美元，而 2012 年 7 月至 2014 年 6 月所述期间为 2 276 美元。出现这一增长的原因是，全球的头等舱和商务舱机票价格呈上涨趋势，其主要原因是，安全措施、燃料附加费和其他运营费用的增加，以及这些费用被转嫁给旅行者。

16. 如果旅行者大会主席、秘书长或常务副秘书长及其配偶或作为秘书长私人代表、被授权代表秘书长旅行的任何其他官员提供近身安保服务，也可允许作为例外情况。如图七所示，在 2016 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期间，共有 93 次旅行，额外费用为 530 565 美元，而 2014 年 6 月终了的所述期间共有 93 次旅行，额外费用为 472 914 美元。

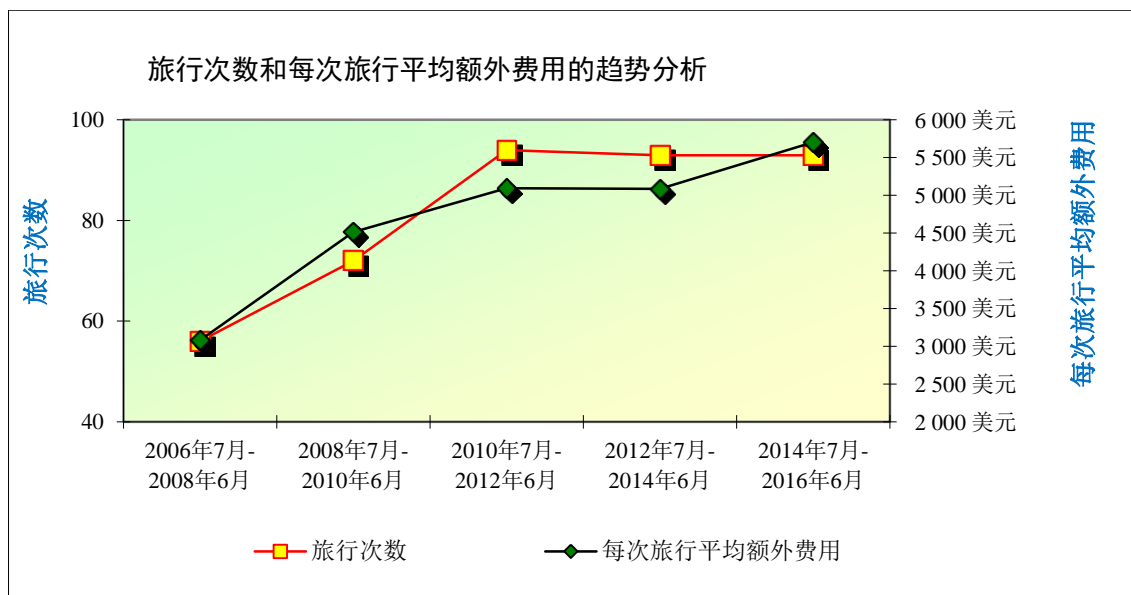

17. 如图八所示，在 2014 年 7 月至 2016 年 6 月所述期间，安保人员每次旅行的平均额外费用为 5 705 美元，而上一个所述期间为 5 085 美元。这一增长可归因于全球头等舱和商务舱机票价格上涨。

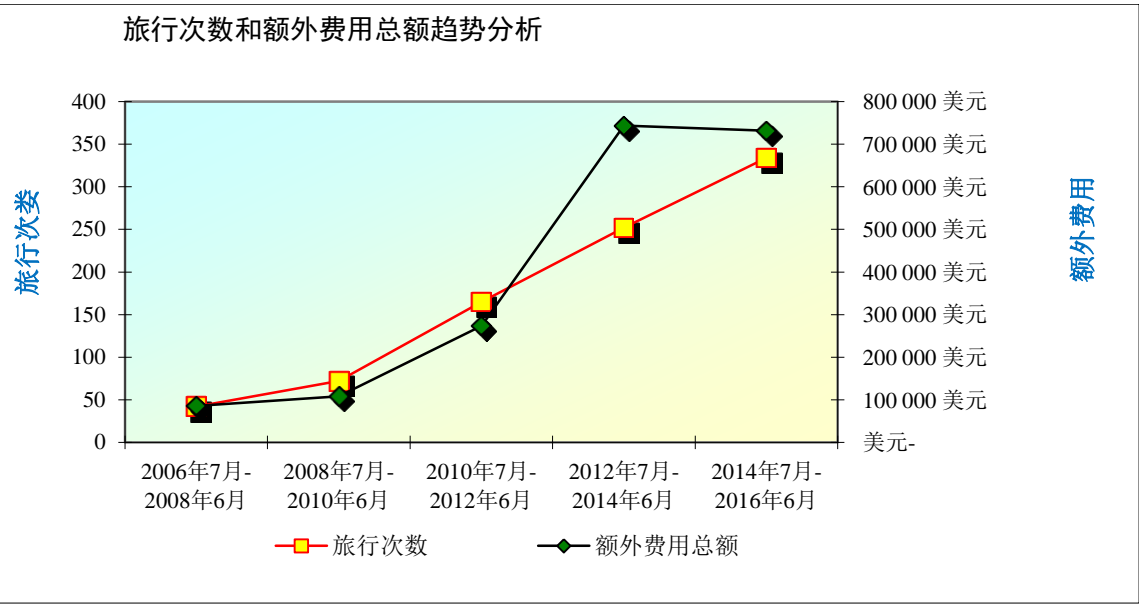

21. 表 5 载列了在 2016 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期为联合国附属实体核准的例外汇总表。为 2014 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期核准的例外汇总表见表 6。附件七至十八分别载列本报告所述期间为联合国开发计划署、联合国儿童基金会、联合国人口基金、联合国促进性别平等和增强妇女权能署、联合国训练研究所、联合国难民事务高级专员公署、联合国环境规划署、联合国人类住区规划署、联合国毒品和犯罪问题办公室、卢旺达问题国际刑事法庭、前南斯拉夫问题国际刑事法庭和联合国气候变化框架公约核准的例外的详细情况。

22. 图九和图十表明，在 2016 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期间，联合国附属实体的旅行次数增加到 334 次，而上一个报告所述期间为 252 次。额外费用总额增加到 731 401 美元，而上一个报告所述期间为 743 389 美元。在 2016 年 6 月 30 日终了两年期间，每次旅行平均额外费用减少到 2 190 美元，而上一个报告所述期间为 2 950 美元。这一减少可归因于各实体提前为旅行进行预订。

为联合国附属实体核准的例外

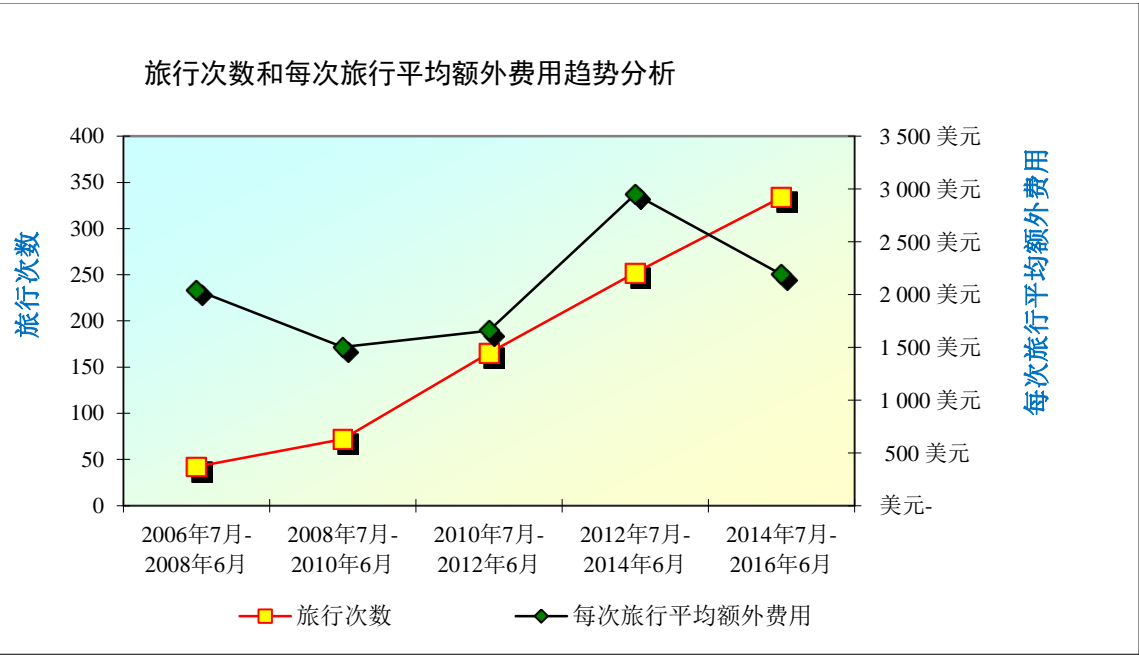

## 五. 飞行常客里程的使用情况

23. 大会第 69/274 A 号决议第四节第 7 段请秘书长继续监测飞行常客里程方面的业界最佳做法，并向大会报告在使用飞行常客里程方面的任何新趋势，以改善差旅问题的行政管理。

24. 秘书处继续监测差旅各方面的最佳做法，包括通过参加“跨机构旅行网”和“旅行服务基准网”这两个差旅管理网络来监测最佳做法。跨机构旅行网是一个技术性工作组，由 75 个国际组织的差旅管理人员组成，包括联合国粮食及农业

组织、美洲开发银行、国际原子能机构、国际民用航空组织、国际刑事法院、国际农业发展基金、国际劳工组织、国际货币基金组织、国际刑警组织、北大西洋条约组织、经济合作与发展组织、欧洲安全与合作组织、联合国艾滋病毒/艾滋病联合规划署、联合国开发计划署、联合国环境规划署(环境规划署)、联合国教育、科学及文化组织、联合国气候变化框架公约、联合国儿童基金会、联合国工业发展组织、世界粮食计划署、世界卫生组织、世界知识产权组织、世界银行和联合国秘书处。旅行服务基准网是一个业界团体，由 15 个组织(几乎全部来自私营部门)的差旅管理人员组成，包括阿西布朗勃法瑞、好事达、波音、戴尔、强生、默克、微软、励讯、西门子、联合技术公司、陶氏、霍尼韦尔、力拓矿业集团、世界银行和联合国秘书处。

25. 为向大会提供飞行常客里程方面的全面最新情况，秘书处在 2016 年 10 月期间从这两个旅行网收集了有关这一专题的资料。

26. 在向机构间旅行网发出信息请求后，共收到 13 个组织的回复。13 个组织中有 3 个组织的差旅方案结合了整体飞行常客里程方案和航空公司(折扣)协议，但应指出，这 3 个组织中只有 1 个组织与不止一家航空公司签订了整体飞行常客里程协议。所有 13 个组织都允许旅行者累积公务差旅所获的里程并将其用于私人旅行。

27. 与公共部门一样，私营部门也较少采用整体飞行常客方案。参与旅行服务基准网的组织均未在公司一级收集飞行常客里程或管理此类方案。

28. 这些公共和私营部门组织普遍认为，管理一个整体飞行常客里程方案是不划算的，原因是管理这样一个方案的成本高于任何相关收益。秘书处注意到，目前这种趋势与先前关于此事项的审查和调查结果一致，在这方面还参考了 2012 年独立咨询人的全面审查结果(见 [A/66/676](#)，第四节)。

29. 如在联合国总部执行这样一个方案，则需管理与公务差旅常用的 70 多家航空公司订立的飞没有想行常客里程方案。此外，飞行常客里程通常只能用于兑换给定航班上有限数量的座位，这限制了它对公务差旅的实际效用，因为公务差旅可能经常要到最后一刻才可以决定并且(或者)需要改变行程。联合国内另一个复杂因素是，需要考虑各种供资来源——通过一个供资来源赚取的里程未必能由另一个供资来源使用。因此，在联合国管理一个整体飞行常客方案会越来越复杂，将需要为此投入大量额外资源。

30. 通过谈判与航空公司达成协议，在机票市场价基础上提供直接折扣，就没有上述弊端。因此，相较于整体飞行常客里程方案，与秘书处规模相当的较大型私营和公共部门组织通常更偏好此类协议。

31. 大会第 [67/254 A](#) 号决议第六节第 2 段认可行政和预算问题咨询委员会报告所载的结论和建议，据此指示秘书处全体工作人员不要将在代表本组织执行公务时

获得的飞行常客里程用于私人旅行，并鼓励工作人员尽可能将此种飞行常客里程用于公务差旅(见 A/66/739，第 11 段)。出于上述原因，在使用公务差旅累积的里程方面，本组织依赖工作人员的诚信。

32. 秘书处在一份经修订的差旅情况通报中重申了这一期望。

## 六. 内部监督事务厅关于全面审计航空旅行活动和相关做法的报告所载建议的执行情况

33. 大会第 69/274 A 号决议第四节第 9 段强调，必须执行内部监督事务厅关于全面审计航空旅行活动和相关做法的报告(A/67/695)所载的各项建议，并请秘书长在今后关于这一主题的报道中详细说明最新执行情况。

34. 内部监督事务厅的报告共包含 22 条建议。秘书长关于飞机舱位标准的上一次报告(A/69/643 和 Corr.1)的附件二十二载有有关这些建议的最新情况介绍。当时，全面执行建议在某些情况下还取决于“团结”系统的实施情况。随后，群组 3 和 4 的各实体分别于 2015 年 6 月和 11 月实施了“团结”系统的旅行模块。因此，本节酌情介绍有关这些建议的最新情况。

35. 目前正在优先和定期提交财务业务情报报告。现阶段已完全有能力提供详细和全面的报告。正在努力尽早提交各份优先报告。

36. 通过采用业务情报报告，进一步改善了对预购机票相关指示的遵守情况的监测。业务情报报告取代了季度报告流程，不用再手工汇总联合国总部各部厅、总部以外办事处和维持和平特派团提交的各种资料。

37. 中央支助事务厅继续与航空公司伙伴合作，在具有可行性并符合本组织最佳利益的情况下，将地方和区域协议并入全球协议，并在秘书处各差旅处理办公室积极推广此类协议。通过洽谈共议定 6 份此类全球协议，还在洽谈另外 5 份协议。应当指出的是，全球折扣在旅游业中仍较罕见。最有吸引力的折扣通常还是在地方和(或)区域一级提供。

38. 为使秘书处各办事处能利用全秘书处各个差旅处理办公室的服务，中央支助事务厅于 2016 年 4 月推出了以固定服务费为形式的费用回收机制。该机制使秘书处各办事处可在本组织能获得最优性价比的地点购买机票，同时允许差旅处理办公室将服务费收入用于提高资源水平或支付与特定交易相关的任何其他费用(如加班费)。该机制的实施处在早期阶段，事实证明还存在各种挑战，因为服务费目前只能事后手动收取，这在实践中限制了该机制的应用。“团结”系统强化后，费用回收服务费将作为“团结”系统旅行申请的一个步骤在事前收取，届时该机制的应用可望大幅增加。不过，预计只有在拟议的全球服务提供模式框架实施后，才能实现真正意义上的全球模式，在全球模式下，若干区域差旅处理办

室将负责完成在本区域内提出申请的差旅安排，而无论差旅资金由哪个办公室提供。此类区域差旅处理办公室将具备最佳条件，能够利用“团结”系统模块所提供的航空旅行完整综合数据，与地方或区域航空公司进行谈判。

39. 在试点阶段，正在对联合国总部目前的票价审计做法作出修正。中央支助事务厅正在聘请独立第三方对联合国总部旅行社进行常规票价审计。这一额外的控制措施到位后，旅行和运输科的工作将从前期并行审计机票改为旅行申请的事后监测和“抽查”，这样旅行股就能把工作重心放到附加值较高的活动上，比如复杂的旅行和业务流程分析。如果试点阶段取得成功，秘书处其他差旅处理办公室也将采用这一流程。

40. 在进一步改进“团结”系统的旅行模块以区别贷项备忘录之后，本组织将能更好地监测取消机票或未使用机票的退款。如果机票在审批过程中需要改签或取消，则由差旅处理办公室负责记录应退还本组织的款项。此外，一旦旅行者在本人的费用报告中确认，有一张部分或完全未使用的机票，系统将生成一份通知发给相关差旅处理办公室，由该办公室负责在系统中记录应收退款。请求售票方实际退款是一个离线流程，实际退款通过上传发票文件贷记到本组织账户。实行这个流程后，本组织将能更好地报告已收到的数额和尚未支付的数额。正在开展必要的系统增强和业务情报报告工作，以提取记录在“团结”系统中的退款请求相关数据。

41. 由于实施了“团结”系统旅行模块，旅行申请的手动处理工作减少。“团结”系统引入了员工自助服务概念，旅行者可直接向系统提交旅行申请，而不像过去那样需要以纸质表格提交申请，再由行政人员输入到一个遗留信息技术系统中。“团结”系统的实施简化了审批流程，审批步骤从 8-12 个(视工作地点而定)减少到 3 个。由于引入了发票自动核对功能，售票方机票支付流程已基本自动化。在费用报告对照初始旅行申请没有变动的情况下，费用报销申请的审批也是自动的。应当指出，尽管在减少差旅端到端流程的手动操作方面取得了重大进展，但是在引入了“团结”系统差旅模块后，各差旅处理办公室的工作量有大幅增加，原因是需要在系统中的几个新增数据域中进行记录，比如用于与航空公司谈判的航班信息、按国际航空运输协会格式填写的用于温室气体报告的行程信息、以及为保证退款而填写的退款信息。最初的“团结”系统变革影响文件预计，工作量将增加 50% 以上，差旅管理人员最近根据部署“团结”系统以来的经验证实了这一点。

42. 维持和平特派团旅行管理服务合同的标准工作说明模板已最后敲定并得到采用，这确保了以标准和一致的方式进行采购和管理旅行社。非维持和平办公室(即总部以外办事处、各经济委员会等)或可采用这一相同模板来订立旅行管理合同。差旅管理人员之间现已建立了良好的协调关系。中央支助事务厅继续每月一次主持召开总部以外办事处、区域委员会和维持和平特派团的差旅管理人员参加的有关差旅业务流程和政策问题的视频会议。还增开另一类月度视频会议，专门



侧重于“团结”系统旅行模块的相关技术问题。这些视频会议的与会者已从差旅管理人员扩大到还包括差旅和运输审批人员(核证员)、人力资源伙伴及其他相关的差旅利益攸关方。该厅目前每年主持召开秘书处差旅管理人员会议，第二次会议于 2016 年 10 月举行。这些会议为秘书处差旅管理人员提供了一个平台，借以提出和讨论共同感兴趣的问题，吸收借鉴全组织的经验和最佳做法。

43. 秘书处对一笔总付选项进行了评估，以确保相关假设仍然成立，而且该选项根据既定标准仍然是合理的。为此收集了来自联合国总部、总部以外办事处以及规模较大的维持和平特派团的数据，这些数据加在一起占外地任务旅行总量的绝大多数，此举是为了对比一笔总付的实际支付金额和本组织在工作人员行使另一种应享福利选项(即由本组织安排票务、终点站费用和相关货运)时理论上应支付的费用。要求每个实体就本实体一笔总付金额最高的十个旅行目的地，提供每个目的地在 2014 年 7 月至 2015 年 6 月期间的 10 份随机取样的旅行核准书，也就是每个实体 100 个数据点(如适用)。从近 1 300 名工作人员(或其家庭成员)获得的数据显示，平均支付给每个有资格的工作人员(或其家庭成员)的一笔总付金额为 2 019 美元，而票价、终点站费用和运费加在一起是 2 560 美元。因此对于秘书处来说，一笔总付选项比替代选项便宜约 541 美元(21%)。还应指出的是，相对于由本组织安排回籍假、探亲或教育补助金项下的旅行事务而言，处理一笔总付要求的管理间接费较低。虽然在定期评估中没有考虑到这一点，但它进一步支持这样的结论，即应鼓励利用一笔总付选项，因为这会减少秘书处的费用。

44. 关于超重行李、托运和保险的 [ST/AI/2015/1](#) 和 [ST/AI/2016/4](#) 号最新行政指示分别于 2015 年 3 月和 2016 年 7 月发布，其中包含先前由原工作人员细则 107.21 规定的应享福利。

45. 在实施大会 2015 年 12 月第 [70/244](#) 号决议核准的新共同制度整套报酬办法的背景下，特别是考虑到国际公务员制度委员会在其年度报告([A/70/30](#))中提议对异地调动托运应享福利(包括对搬迁补助金一笔总付的最高限额)作出调整，秘书处正与联合国共同制度的其他组织共同审议应否及如何调整目前的一笔总付金额，包括审议地理“分区”方法对本组织而言是否适宜和符合成本效益。为确保工作人员无论受雇于哪一个联合国系统实体都获得同类服务条件，与共同制度其他基金和方案以及专门机构进行协调至关重要。

## 七. 关于航空旅行活动的全面资料和在旅行管理中实施“团结”系统所产生的影响

46. 大会在第 [69/274](#) 号决议 A 第四节第 10 段中回顾行预咨委会报告([A/69/787](#))第 32 至 34 段，并请秘书长在下次报告中提供关于航空旅行活动的全面资料。

47. 大会在同一决议第四节第 14 段中，请秘书长在下一次报告中向大会提出全面信息，说明在差旅管理中实施“团结”系统所产生的影响，包括涉及联合国航空旅行所有领域的最新信息、趋势和分析。

48. 由于“团结”系统的差旅模块还提供关于航空旅行活动的全面信息，本报告中对大会的上述要求作出综合回应。秘书长对第一次能够向大会提出关于航空旅行活动的全面资料感到高兴。这一全面资料的依据是从业务情报模块提取的“团结”系统差旅模块的数据。

49. “团结”系统差旅模块已分阶段部署。<sup>1</sup> 模块于 2014 年 7 月在联合国海地稳定特派团试行。在试点阶段成功后，又于 2015 年 6 月向第 3 群组推出。2015 年 11 月，包括联合国总部的第 4 群组实体也开始启用这一模块。

50. 在目前阶段，在秘书处的所有差旅都是通过“团结”系统差旅模块处理，但本国工作人员和维持和平特派团军警人员不在此列，将在该模块充分稳定后纳入这些人员。

51. 在审查全面信息、尤其是在审查不同年份的信息时，需要铭记“团结”系统的实施工作采用了分阶段方式。显然，如果秘书处不同部门是在不同时间安装“团结”系统的差旅模块，那就无法对各年度的数据进行比较。随着这一模块在秘书处全面启用，今后可比性会日趋提高。

52. 尽管在持续稳定性和业务流程改革管理方面仍然面临着一些挑战，但在差旅行政管理方面执行“团结”系统的总体影响是积极的(见上文第 41 段关于涉及旅行福利情况的概述)。这些内容已酌情列入“团结”系统带来的总体效益之中。

53. 使用一个共同平台(“团结”差旅)有可能形成新的组织结构。由于“团结”系统中有 59 个差旅处理办事处，差旅的办理依然各自为政，从而对减少差旅支出、实施统一政策、满足支助需求及采用网上预订工具等新技术造成限制。因此，秘书长关于全球服务交付模式的报告(A/71/417)提议，今后应建立一个更集中统一的差旅架构。

54. 一个意想不到的后果是，员工自助服务概念的采用导致支持需求增加(见上文第 41 段)。“团结”系统实施以来，在 iNeed 系统内总共提交 116 000 份服务单及工作单中，有 11 000 项涉及差旅。这一新的支持需求给中央支助事务厅带来巨大的负担，因为差旅资源并没有随着要求流程所有人承担新的角色和支持而相应增加。如上文所述，“团结”系统差旅模块实施后，差旅资源方面的总体工作量大幅增加，但并没有对资源进行内部调配。资源的缺乏也影响到其他领域，如业务情报报告和分析，并影响了流程所有人充分利用“团结”系统潜力的能力。

55. 与 SAP 公司的“标准”旅行模块相比，“团结”系统差旅模块是一种高度定制化模块。业已进行了专门定制工作，以达到涉及秘书处差旅所有方面的政策和报告要求。但显而易见的是，这种高度定制化对“团结”系统差旅模块的有效运作产生了不利影响。特别是，跨职能整合问题(例如旅行模块和财务模块之间的整合)依然存在，因此需要专业人员的支持。在群组 3 和 4 部署后建立的工作队报告的所有问题中，约有 10%与差旅有关。尽管在处理最紧迫的问题方面已经取得进展，但稳定模块的工作仍在继续。

56. 建立差旅业务情报环境的工作正在进行中。在“团结”系统与信息和通信技术厅的协助下，第一个报告环境已于 2016 年中期交付。在测试过程中确定了进一步的要求。目前正对其进行交付和测试。业务情报报告预计将在 2017 年期间分阶段向最终用户提供。

57. 因此，秘书长很高兴在以下各段中向大会介绍根据行预咨委会的报告(A/69/787)第 32-34 段的要求提交的有关航空旅行活动的最新资料。

58. 必须指出，以下各表及相关附件以“团结”系统中 2014 年 7 月到 2016 年 6 月的数据为依据。由于秘书处的具体部门在整个这一时期分阶段实施了“团结”系统，因此无法对不同报告年份的数据进行有实际意义的比较。

#### 差旅数量、频率和目的

59. 表 7 概述了 2014 年 7 月至 2016 年 6 月期间每一差旅类别的旅行次数。这些数字包括所有的旅行方式，如商业飞机、联合国飞机、火车、机动车辆等。

63. 费用细分为“机票”费用和“其他”费用。“其他”类别包括所有非机票费用，如每日生活津贴、终点站费用等。系统目前还不能提供实际非机票费用的详尽细目，因为这些费用仅在财务模块中汇总记录。

#### 预购政策的遵守情况

66. 在主要公务差旅的类别内，遵守规定的比率从 2015 年的 25% 稳步增加到 2016 年上半年的 32%。应享差旅待遇和人力资源差旅两类显示了类似的积极趋势，目前分别为 52% 和 31%。鉴于 2014 年下半年“团结”系统差旅模块部署的范围有限(仅限于联海稳定团试点)，在分析遵守情况时未考虑这一数据。

67. 预购政策的遵守情况由于向“团结”系统差旅模块的过渡而受到不利影响。公务差旅人员、差旅行政管理人员和核准人员花时间充分了解新的模块和相关的工作流程和业务程序。在部署各个群组之前，采取了一至二周的所谓“下线”做法，在此期间任何业务交易都无法在遗留系统或“团结”系统模块中记载。新模块“启用”后，这些业务交易以追溯方式记入“团结”系统中，而且往往是在接近差旅日期或差旅之后记入。此外，系统部署以来影响到差旅模块的各种问题也导致了差旅批准程序的延误。

68. 随着系统使用者的熟练程度提高，以及“团结”系统差旅模块进一步稳定，遵守规定的情况预计将会逐步改善。然而，如要在部门一级实现重大改进，还需要改进规划。按“团结”系统业务领域分列的遵守规定情况请参看附件二十二。

69. 为能够将秘书处内机票预购方面的合规率与其他组织作一比较，附件二十三载列了跨机构旅行网各组织的行业基准。虽然改善遵守规定情况并达到“低等”合规率组群的平均水平是可能的，但是，鉴于秘书处许多部门具有独特的、急事急办性质，要在“中等”、“高等”合规组织的水平上开展业务可能具有难度。“中等”、“高等”合规组织通常具有更稳定和更可预测的差旅模式。

## 八. 通过执行决议第 67/254 号决议第六节所取得成果的综合数据

70. 大会按照第 69/274 A 号决议第四节第 13 段的规定，请秘书长提交关于执行第 67/254 号决议第六节所取得成果的综合数据。

71. 经修订的差旅政策(ST/AI/2013/3)于 2013 年 8 月推出。在秘书长上一次关于飞机舱位标准的报告(A/69/643)提交后向行预咨委会提供的补充资料和说明中，中央支助事务厅表示，2014 年由联合国总部所安排差旅的平均机票价格降低了 8.9%。遗憾的是，当时无法提供整个秘书处的统计数据。

72. 与此同时，中央支助事务厅从较大的秘书处差旅处理办事处那里收集了关于 2013 年至 2014 年平均票价资料。这些办事处加在一起约占秘书处航空旅行的 80%，因此被认为是具有代表性的抽样。2014 年，这些办事处的平均票价下降了 6.1%。

73. 随着新的差旅政策在 2013 第三季度生效，可以假定，修订差旅政策是出现所述的平均票价逐年递减情况的主要根本因素。

74. 应该指出，因 2013 年执行经修订的差旅政策而实现的“一次性”节余可望得到维持，但不应期待这一政策的修订将带来进一步的费用节省。2015 年及其后的平均票价同样取决于总体行业定价动态。

75. 差旅总开支受到许多因素的影响，包括不断变化的旅行模式、业务需求和价格水平，因此，在今后几年继续计算 2013 年经修订差旅政策的影响没有意义。

## 九. 对联合国航空旅行等级的舱位标准的评估

76. 大会在第 69/274 A 号决议第四节中核可行预咨委会的报告(A/69/787)所载的结论和建议，其中建议秘书长提出一份联合国航空旅行等级的舱位标准的评估，并在必要时就此提出建议。

77. 为了向大会提供舱位标准的全面最新资料，秘书处 2016 年 10 月期间从跨机构旅行网和旅行业务基准网收集了关于这一专题的资料。

78. 13 个属于跨机构旅行网的组织的回复显示，这些公共部门组织的公务舱旅行平均门槛是 6.4 小时旅行时间，最短为三个小时，最长 9 小时。

79. 旅行业务基准网组织的回复显示，其公务舱旅行门槛与上述标准相似：平均门槛为 6.8 小时旅行时间，最短为 5 个小时，最长 12 个小时。

80. 应当指出，每个组织计算旅行时间的方式不同。一些组织顾及了中途停留因素，而另一些组织则认为，旅行时间等同于飞行时间。

81. 如果旅行时间超过预定门槛值，绝大多数组织仍然规定提供公务舱标准，认为这是适当的舱位标准。跨机构旅行网中仅有两个组织认为，所谓的“高端经济舱”在这种情况下是适当的舱位标准。这可能是由于各航空公司提供的高端经济舱产品有很大差异、供应量也大，有的可能仅提供免费餐饮，有些也提供略多的座椅空间。并非所有航空公司都一贯地提供高端经济舱产品。就是在同一家航空公司，可以提供的此类舱位可能不仅在不同航线之间存在差异，甚至在同一航线也取决于飞机的情况。因此，通常尚未认为高端经济舱产品可以替代公务舱。

82. 与秘书处一样，其他组织似乎也在旅行者自愿从更高标准的舱位降级时，把高端经济舱产品作为标准。

83. 航空公司继续改善基本经济舱以外的舱位标准，因此有人建议定期重新评估舱位标准，以确保秘书处的差旅政策与总体行业发展情况相一致。

## 十. 一笔总付办法

84. 大会第 67/254 A 号决议决定，在 2015 年完成的审查结果出台之前，作为一项临时措施，秘书长应修订与旅行相关的一笔总付方式的规定，将其改为等同于



受限最少的经济舱票价的 70%。大会还请秘书长在向大会第六十九届会议提交的关于飞机舱位标准的报告中分析执行这一规定的影响，并就修改一笔总付办法提出其他建议。秘书长的报告(A/69/643 和 Corr.1)附件二十二第 19 至 30 段提供所要求的资料，其中秘书长建议，在根据取得的进一步经验和对经验的分析提出新的建议之前，拟议将一笔总付的规定维持在受限最少的经济舱票价的 70%水平。

85. 大会在其第 69/274 A 号决议中注意到秘书长的报告，并赞同行政和预算问题咨询委员会的报告(A/69/787)第 22 至 24 段中载列的相关建议。尤其是，行预咨委会认为，应鼓励工作人员更多采用一笔总付选择，并建议进行进一步分析，以期找到合适的平衡点，在进一步减少一笔总付所能实现的效率与愿意使用一笔总付选项的工作人员减少从而导致成本(包括出票的行政成本)增加之间求得平衡，并在其下次报告中说明分析结果。该项研究还应考虑到并估算出因使用一笔总付选项而减少的行政工作量。

86. 秘书处从 2014 年 6 月至 2015 年 6 月期间在部署“团结”系统之前所作的进一步分析显示，与机票选项的总费用方式(机票、机场费用和运输费用)相比，现行办法规定的一笔总付选项可把每一旅行者的费用平均降低约 21%。然而，对 2016 年 1 月至 8 月已有的“团结”系统差旅数据所作的初步分析表明，一笔总付办法的接受率已从 93%下降到 74%，其余 26%的工作人员选择由联合国组织提供机票和相关福利，从而使组织花费更多的资金。

87. 鉴于到 2016 年才有可能收集和分析“团结”系统的差旅信息，以及工作人员每 24 个月只可进行一次回籍假旅行，因此，在编写本报告之时无法作出全面分析。因此，秘书长打算继续根据“团结”系统的差旅数据，审查一笔总付办法的实施情况，包括分析因愿意采用一次总付办法的工作人员数量减少而导致行政费用(以及直接费用)增加的问题，并在向大会第七十三届会议第一期续会提交的关于航空旅行舱位标准的下一次报告中，就今后如何改变提出建议。

88. 秘书长还将与联合国共同制度其他各组织协调，探讨是否可能维持共同制度在差旅政策方面的一致性，但应当指出，这些组织大都根据不受限制的全额经济舱票价的 75%至 80%的标准，继续提供较为慷慨的一次总付选项(这一点已在秘书长关于航空旅行舱位标准的上一次报告(A/69/643)附件二十二第 21 段中指出)。
