مسألة قبرص

رسالة مؤرخة ٧ آب/أغسطس ٢٠١٨ موجهة من القائم بالأعمال بالنيابة للبعثة الدائمة لجمهورية قبرص لدى الأمم المتحدة إلى الأمين العام

بناءً على تعليمات من حكومي، أحيل إليكم طيه وثيقتين تفصّلان خروقات قواعد الحركة الجوية الدولية وانتهاكات المجال الجوي الوطني لجمهورية قبرص من جانب تركيا (انظر المرفق الأول) واستخدام السفن الحربية التركية غير القانوني للموانئ المغلقة (انظر المرفق الثاني) خلال شهر حزيران/يونيه ٢٠١٨.

وأود أيضاً أن أحيطكم علماً بأن نظام الاحتلال أصدر بصورة غير قانونية تنبيهين إلى الطيارين، في حزيران/يونيه ٢٠١٨، بشأن المناورات التي أجرتها القوات الجوية التركية.

وجدير بالإشارة أن الطائرات التجارية التركية دأبت على استخدام مطار تيمبو غير القانوني. وإضافة إلى ذلك، فإن تركيا تواصل بشكل ممنهج مضايقتها للطائرات المدنية والعسكرية داخل منطقة نيقوسيا لمعلومات الطيران عن طريق الاتصالات اللاسلكية. وفي غضون ذلك، لا تزال عمليات خرق منطقة نيقوسيا لمعلومات الطيران وانتهاكات المجال الجوي الوطني لجمهورية قبرص متواصلة بلا هوادة. وإن سياسة تركيا المتمثلة في الاستمرار في خرق القانون الدولي وتحدي القواعد والأنظمة الدولية تعرّض للخطر سلامة الطيران المدني الدولي، وتخلّف آثاراً سلبية على الاستقرار في المنطقة، وتتسبّب في صعوبات تعرقل الحركة الجوية فوق قبرص.

ومن الواضح أن الأعمال المشار إليها أعلاه التي تقوم بها تركيا، التي تحتل الجزء الشمالي من جمهورية قبرص بصورة غير قانونية منذ عام ١٩٧٤، هي أعمال تستهدف تقويض سيادة جمهورية قبرص، وترسيخ الانقسام المستمر بحكم الأمر الواقع، وتحسين مركز الكيان الانفصالي بادعاء الحق في مجال جوي مزعوم فوق الأراضي المحتلة من الجمهورية. وفي هذا الصدد، أود أن أؤكد مرة أخرى أنه ليس هناك سوى



سلطة قانونية واحدة في قبرص، هي جمهورية قبرص، وفقا لما تنص عليه قرارات متعددة لمجلس الأمن، ولا سيما القراران ٥٤١ (١٩٨٣) و ٥٥٠ (١٩٨٤)، اللذان أعلن فيهما المجلس أن إنشاء ما يسمى "الجمهورية التركية لشمال قبرص" هو إجراء باطل لا مفعول له.

وإني، باسم حكومة بلدي، أحتج بشدّة على استمرار خروقات تركيا لقواعد الملاحة الجوية الدولية وانتهاكاتها للمجال الجوي الوطني وللمياه الإقليمية لجمهورية قبرص، وأدعوها إلى الكفّ عن ذلك فوراً. وتؤكد جمهورية قبرص مجدداً، في هذا الصدد، دعوتها إلى التقيد بمبدأ السيادة وعدم التدخل المكرّس في ميثاق الأمم المتحدة.

وأخيراً، أود أن أحث تركيا والقبارصة الأتراك على الاستجابة لنداءات المجتمع الدولي والإسهام في استئناف عملية السلام بشكل جدي، بدلا من التركيز على تقويض سيادة جمهورية قبرص وترسيخ الانقسام المستمر بحكم الأمر الواقع وتعزيز مركز الكيان الانفصالي.

وأرجو ممتنا تعميم هذه الرسالة ومرفقيها باعتبارها وثيقة من وثائق الجمعية العامة، في إطار البند ٤٤ من جدول أعمال، ومن وثائق مجلس الأمن.
