الجمعية العامة الدورة الثالثة والسبعون البند ٥٥ من جدول الأعمال مسألة قبرص

رسالة مؤرخة ٢٩ تشـرين الثاني/نوفمبر ٢٠١٨ موجهة إلى الأمين العام من الممثل الدائم لقبرص لدى الأمم المتحدة

بناء على تعليمات من حكومتي، أحيل إليكم طيه وثيقتين تفصلان انتهاكات الجال الجوي الوطني لقبرص وحروقات قواعد الحركة الجوية الدولية داخل منطقة قبرص لمعلومات الطيران (انظر المرفق الأول) والاستخدام غير القانوني من جانب تركيا للموانئ والمطارات المغلقة (انظر المرفق الثاني) خلال شهر تشرين الأول/أكتوبر ٢٠١٨.

وهذه السياسة القائمة على الإمعان في انتهاك القانون الدولي وخرق القواعد والأنظمة الدولية، تشكل خطراً مستمراً على السلام والأمن الدوليين، وتؤثر تأثيراً سلبياً على الاستقرار الإقليمي، وتعرِّض للخطر سلامة الطيران المديي الدولي، وتطرح مصاعب أمام حركة الملاحة الجوية فوق قبرص، وتحول دون تهيئة بيئة مواتية تجرى في إطارها عملية السلام في قبرص.

وتواصل تركيا مضايقتها المنهجية للطائرات المدنية والعسكرية داخل منطقة نيقوسيا لمعلومات الطيران عن طريق الاتصالات اللاسلكية. فخلال شهر تشرين الأول/أكتوبر ٢٠١٨، قام النظام الذي نصبته السلطة القائمة بالاحتلال في منطقة قبرص التي تحتلها بصورة غير قانونية بإصدار نشرة واحدة إلى الطيارين بشأن المناورات التي أجرتها القوات الجوية التركية. وإضافة إلى ذلك، تستخدم الطائرات التجارية التركية بصفة منتظمة مطار تيمبو، الذي يستمر تشغيله بصورة غير قانونية منذ إغلاق حكومة قبرص جميع نقاط الدخول في المناطق التي لا تمارس فيها سيطرة فعلية.

ومن الواضح أن الأعمال المذكورة التي تقوم بما تركيا، التي تواصل احتلال الجزء الشمالي من جمهورية قبرص منذ عام ١٩٧٤، هي أعمال تستهدف تقويض سيادة قبرص، وترسيخ الانقسام الجاري بحكم الأمر الواقع، وتعزيز وضع الكيان الانفصالي بادعاء حق مزعوم في مجال جوي فوق الأراضي المحتلة





من الجمهورية. وفي هذا الصدد، أود أن أؤكد مرة أخرى أنه ليس هناك سوى دولة قبرصية واحدة هي جمهورية قبرص، على نحو ما تنص على ذلك مختلف قرارات مجلس الأمن (ولا سيما القراران ٤١٥) جمهورية قبرص (٩٨٣) و ٥٥٠ (١٩٨٤)، التي أعلن فيها المجلس أن الانفصال المزعوم لجزء من جمهورية قبرص انفصالٌ باطل من المنظور القانوني.

وباسم حكومة بلدي، أحتج بشدّة على تمادي تركيا في انتهاكاتما للمجال الجوي الوطني وللمياه الإقليمية لقبرص، وكذلك على خروقاتما لقواعد الملاحة الجوية الدولية، وأدعو إلى الكفّ عن ذلك فوراً.

وفي هذا الصدد، تكرر جمهورية قبرص تأكيد دعوتها جميع الدول إلى احترام قرارات مجلس الأمن والتقيد بمبدأي السيادة وعدم التدخل المكرّسين في ميثاق الأمم المتحدة.

وختاماً، أود أن أحث تركيا والقبارصة الأتراك على الإسهام الهادف في استئناف عملية السلام، بدلا من التركيز على تقويض سيادة جمهورية قبرص والترويج لتقسيم قبرص عن طريق خلق حقائق على الأرض وترسيخ الوضع القائم، بما في ذلك من خلال السعى إلى تعزيز الكيان الانفصالي سياسياً.

وأرجو ممتناً تعميم هذه الرسالة ومرفقيها باعتبارها وثيقة من وثائق الجمعية العامة، في إطار البند ٤٥ من جدول الأعمال، ومن وثائق مجلس الأمن.
