Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 62nd meeting, on 10 December 1982, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/37/79) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution G recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 44 of its report (A/37/670) as well as the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/37/7/Add.16).
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/37/SR.62).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 76 votes to 1, with 10 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution G recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 44 of its report (A/37/670), an additional appropriation of \$134,300 would be required under section 2 of the programme budget for the biennium 1982-1983. Provision of \$10,600 would also have to be made under section 31 (Staff assessment), to be offset by an increase in the same amount under Income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
4. Statements in explanation of vote were made by the representatives of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics and the United States of America.
