## STATEMENT BY VIETNAM NEWS AGENCY

On February 1, 1983, the spokesman for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand declared that Vietnamese troops in Kampuchea had attacked a civilian refugee camp in Kampuchean territory.

Vietnam News Agency is authorized to completely reject the abovementioned slanderous accusation.

It is common knowledge that the remnants of Pol Potist and other Khmer reactionary forces armed and fed by Beijing, using their sanctuaries in Thai territory as staging bases, have frequently intruded into Kampuchean territory and have committed many crimes against the Kampuchean people. In defense of the sovereignty, security and territorial integrity of their country and the revival of their people, the revolutionary armed forces of Kampuchea are fully entitled to take action to duly punish these reactionary forces for their crimes. The slanderous accusation and fabrication levelled by Thailand against Vietnamese forces in Kampuchea can in no way cover up that truth and only benefit the Beijing expansionists and hegemonists who are plotting to reimpose the genocidal Pot Pot regime on the Kampuchean people.
