Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 36th meeting, on 25 November 1986, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements submitted by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/41/51, A/C.5/41/48, A/C.5/41/52 and A/C.5/41/49) on the programme budget implications of the following draft resolutions recommended by the First Committee under agenda items 61 (i), 62, 62 (o): draft resolution entitled "Convening of the third special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament" (A/41/841, para. 32, draft resolution G);

**draft resolution entitled "Review of the implementation of the recommendations and decisions adopted by the General Assembly at its tenth special session" (A/41/842, para. 68, draft resolution I) ; draft resolution entitled "Prevention of nuclear war" (A/41/842, para. 68, draft resolution G) ; and of the draft decision under agenda item 65 entitled "International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development" (A/41/844, para. 8). The Fifth committee had before it the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/41/7/Add.10).**

2. Statements and **comments** made in the course of the Committee's **consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/41/SR.36) .**

#### DECISIONS OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

##### **A. Third special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament**

3. The Fifth **Committee decided**, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution G recommended by the First **Committee in paragraph 32 of its report (A/41/841)**, no additional appropriations would be required under the **programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987**. Conference-servicing requirements **would arise**, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$633,800. The actual appropriation that might be **required in that respect would be considered** in the context of the consolidated **statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session**. Furthermore, the adoption of the draft resolution **would constitute** an exception to General Assembly resolutions **37/14 C and 40/243**.

##### **B. Review of the implementation of the recommendations and decisions adopted by the General Assembly at its tenth special session**

4. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 78 to 3, with 10 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution I recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 68 of its **report (A/41/842)**, an **additional appropriation of \$37,800 would be required under section 2B of the programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987**. **Conference-servicing requirements would arise, which are estimated, on a full cost basis, at \$207,500**. The **actual appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session**.

### **c. Prevention of Nuclear War**

6. The Fifth Committee decided, by a recorded vote of 83 to 4, with 8 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution G recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 68 of its report (A/41/842), an additional appropriation of \$41,100 would be required under section B of the programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987. Conference-servicing requirements would arise, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$250,400. The actual appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.

7. The voting was as follows;

D. Relationship between disarmament and development

8. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft decision recommended by the First Committee in paragraph 8 of its report (A/41/844), no additional appropriation would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1986-1987.

Conference-servicing requirements would arise, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$341,600. The actual appropriation that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
